- Due to the 6% budget limitation law it is impossible to provide county road funds within the regular budget.
- Therefore at the present time no one is paying any taxes in support of the county road system.
- A 3-mill levy is at the rate of \$3.00 tax per \$1000.00 assessed valuation. This would increase taxes on the average home by three to five dollars, and on the average farm by about ten dollars per year. Check your own tax receipt to see what it would cost you.
- Property owners generally will pay only about one-half of this tax, and five or six large firms such as the utilities, railroads and lumber companies will pay the rest.
- Indirectly you are paying for these roads now—and still not getting good roads. Would you rather pay big car repair bills caused by rough roads, or save this by building good roads?
- The county now has many miles of roads that are constructed and ready for oil. This 3-mill levy will get these roads finished. Otherwise the present investment will be lost through quick deterioration.
