

Boy Scouts Make Plans For Summer

Klamath Basin Boy Scout groups are beginning plans for summer activities with the advent of vacation, and troops are starting preparations for camp programs.

Important to local scouts is Camp Makualla, located at Crescent lake, where the camping program will begin on July 11. Two weeks of construction and camp repair will precede the actual beginning of the program, however, with both adults and scouts working.

More than 400 scouts are expected to attend Camp Makualla at some time or other during the summer program, according to Bob Lamott, Boy Scout executive. Lamott said more than 300 used facilities at Crescent lake last summer, these coming from 25 or 30 troops in this area.

John Raffetto, field executive, will be in charge of the program this summer, with Fremont Executive Robert Gamage assisting him. Activities at Makualla will run five or six weeks, depending on attendance. The same \$15 per week fee will be in effect this summer as last.

The Lake district will be host for this year's Modoc area council rendezvous. The three-day affair will be held this year at Dog lake, in the Quartz mountain area. Various Scout patrols will compete in camp-conducting, and will receive corresponding awards for their efforts at the close of the rendezvous.

Bishop Sees Change In German Outlook

WASHINGTON, May 19 (AP)—Bishop Hanns Lilje of the Lutheran church of Hanover told President Truman Tuesday there are signs of "spiritual reawakening" in Germany.

The bishop, once imprisoned by the nazis, said the spiritual revival was most noticeable among youth and the educated classes.

He said he called on Mr. Truman to express his gratitude for the people of his country who had been enabled to survive by American aid.

Bishop Lilje is in this country visiting Lutheran centers and re-establishing relations broken off by the war.

He told reporters he was kept in solitary confinement and in chains for ten months because of his public position in opposition to the nazi regime.

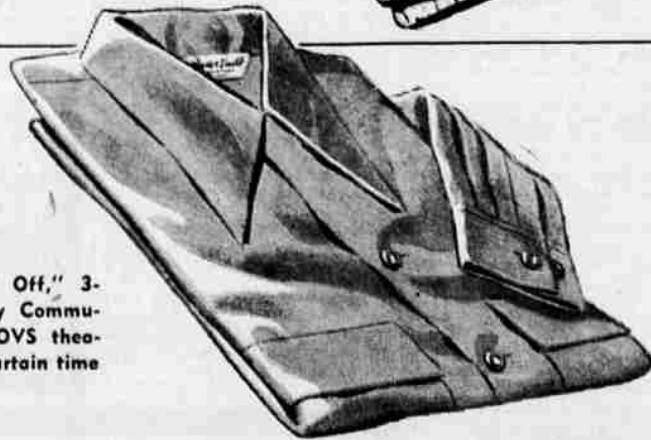

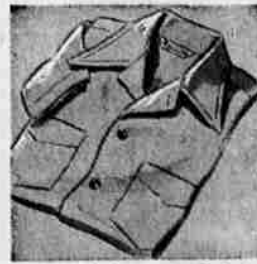
