Ed Geary Is Top Man For Legislature

TOLEDO, O., May 22 (AP)—George F. Gomersall died on a sidewalk yesterday while two dogs fought each other over his body until police killed them, Coroner Paul G. Hohly said.

The 55-year-old Toledo man had taken his huge Boxer dog out for a walk. The dog and a neighbor's cocker spaniel began to fight and Gomersall slipped to the sidewalk with a heart attack.

Police shot the two dogs so members of the rescue squad could reach the man. He was dead when he arrived at a Toledo hospital.

Coroner Paul Hohly said Gomersall died as his pet stood over him fighting the spaniel.

Neither was there a contest for state senator from this district, Phil Hitchcock, republican, and Marcus Peterson, democrat, were unopposed for the nomination.

So much for the purely local contests. D. E. Van Vactor has the sole nomination for district attorney, Charlie DeLap for county clerk, C. L. Langset for treasurer and Dr. George H. Adler for coroner.

One other contest is shaping up for November, that for the job of county assessor, but yesterday's primary voting merely made concrete the fact that Glen Terrill is the GOP nominee and Otis Metaker is the democratic aspirant. Both were unopposed.

General Lead State contests saw Klamath county following the general lead in favoring Tom Dewey over Harold Stassen for GOP nomination preference, Earl Newbury for GOP secretary of state nomination, Byron Carney for the democratic bid to the same office, Manley Wilson for the demo nomination as U. S. senator and Lowell Stockman for re-nomination to congress on the republican ticket.

But in the matter of governor and state treasurer the county spoke its own piece. John Hall had a clean majority over Doug McKay for GOP gubernatorial candidate in Klamath county and Sigfried Unander was the local winner of the three-way GOP run for state treasurer, while Howard Belton was the statewide winner.
