

KFPA's Fire Fight School Under Way

The three-day fire prevention school for Klamath Forest Protective association personnel started at 8 a. m. Monday with a class in orientation and public relations. Maintenance of buildings and equipment, fire reports and other forms, radio communication and FCC regulations and proper use of equipment were studied throughout Monday.

Classes for KFPA personnel and other invited groups will continue Tuesday with fire lookouts being taken to Hogback mountain for training. Others will go out for fire chasing problems, compass and pacing, fire mapping, progressive methods of fire line construction and control of small fires.

Map reading, field location of fires and fire mapping, time keeping for fire fighting field crews, law enforcement and fire behavior will be included in Tuesday's classes.

On Wednesday the group will study fire organization on large fires, control of large fires, use of water equipment and district policy.

Classes are being conducted by Jim Walker, Don Maus and William Saunders of Salem, Hal Ogle and Clarence Williams of KFPA and Earl Tichenor.

Youth Finds Body Of "Cave-Dweller"

PORTLAND, May 25 (AP)—The body of a Mexican cave-dwelling youth found in the brush under Ross Island bridge spanning the Willamette river gave police a new mystery to work on today.

Detective Tom Tennant reported the body of Eddie Carmelito Garcia, 18, was discovered by boys who had peered over the bridge railing. Cause of the death was not determined.

Investigation revealed a makeshift cave dugout in which two blankets and some clothing were found. Nearby were scattered the tin cans and utensils the boy used in what police said was a hobo existence.

A birth certificate gave Garcia's birthplace as Pocatello, Idaho.
