

# Summer Home Prowls Told

Fifteen summer homes at Lake of the Woods, owned by Klamath Falls, Medford, Ashland and Alturas residents, were prowled sometime during the past several days according to Troy Cook, president of the Summer Home Owners association, who went Wednesday at the resort.

Cook said that it appeared the prowlers reached the west side cabins by boat, systematically opened summer homes by using a pinch bar on doors or locks, and went through each cabin seeking loot which would make a quick turn-over.

Thus far the only missing article is an outboard motor from the R. P. Ellington Sr. place, but Cook asks cabin owners to check their buildings and to report the loss to Sheriff Lloyd L. Low. Caretaker Ed Morse was making a further check today.

Cook said that cabins entered included those owned by R. P. Ellington Sr., O. C. Lorenz, E. L. Weaver, Glenn Kent, Clarence A. Humble, Lawrence Blaw, and Dr.

C. B. Morrison, all of Klamath Falls; Barney Smith of Alturas; Marshall Besonette, Taves and Blackburn, L. Faber, William Briggs, Dave Homes and Walter Leverett of Medford, and G. Eiders of Ashland.

Only cabins prowled on the east side were those of Shaw and Eiders.
