

# Home Economics Council Plans Drive For House

The state-wide project of the Oregon home economics extension council to raise funds for erecting a cooperative house for girls on the Oregon State college campus is well under way with more than \$9000 raised to date. Plans for completing the \$45,000 goal set to be raised over a period of three years were made when the board of trustees for the building fund met in Portland recently.

Klamath county home extension women have contributed over \$350 since the beginning of the year. Most of the money has been raised by the women through money raising affairs of various kinds.

The project was endorsed recently by a prominent Portland business firm which contributed \$2500 to the fund, according to an announcement made at a recent board meeting by Mrs. Norman Lund of Troutdale, chairman.

Adopted by the state council two years ago, the project when completed will be a means of making moderately priced housing available for about 50 or 60 girls each year, thus relieving the acute housing shortage for women at the college. Girls to live in this cooperative dormitory will be selected by the respective county home extension committees on a basis of scholarship, leadership, and character, with a preference given to 4-H girls. The house will also be used as a meeting place for the state council at its annual summer meetings on the Oregon State college campus.

"Azalea House" has been chosen as the name of the dormitory which is to provide a standard of living comparable to any at the college and at a minimum cost. The proposed site of the building is on the lower campus near the Madison street gates which mark the east entrance.
