

2,4-D, The Newest Wonder Chemical, Should Be Used With Extreme Caution

The hazards of 2,4-D, the new wonder chemical, are stressed by C. A. Henderson, county agent, this week in a warning against indiscriminate use.

2,4-D is not only deadly to weeds but to such plants as flowers and vegetables, the county agent emphasizes.

Many friendships have been broken, neighbors become hostile and even damage suits have resulted in the United States from mis-use of this material. When it is used on lawns in town as dust or spray it may drift to an adjacent flower or vegetable plot.

Such garden plants are sensitive to this chemical and even a trifling invisible drift across a boundary line can cause widespread killing. Serious injury to some commercial crops resulted last year even where only mild breezes were prevalent.

Rice fields dusted with air with 2,4-D were free of weeds but adjacent cotton fields were seriously injured. Damage from drifting dust and spray was also reported in potato and other crops throughout the nation.

Current dandelion spraying is common in towns throughout the county, Henderson points out and unless every caution is observed loss in neighboring gardens may result.

One definite point to consider is the wind. Only on the stillest days should the spray and dust be used. Another consideration should be to avoid application in ditches which will carry irrigation water within the next few days.

Greater demand for 2,4-D is seen this year in Klamath basin than ever before, said Henderson, following the heavy growth of weeds flourishing with late rains and the myriads of dandelions dotting the landscape.

A special warning for caution in using the wonder chemical is issued by the U. S. department of agriculture and repeated by the county agent to "Use 2,4-D but use it carefully."

Pressure May Be Used In Home Canning

A pressure saucan may be successfully used for small jobs of home canning provided the saucan meets certain requirements, and provided processing times scientifically adapted to saucans are used, specialists of the U. S. department of agriculture report.

For home canning, a saucan must be tall enough to hold pint jars on a rack with the saucan cover locked in place, and the saucan must have a gauge that allows pressure to be controlled accurately at 10 pounds.

To sterilize vegetables for safe-keeping, processing times at 10 pounds pressure must be 20 minutes longer in a saucan than the times recommended for a pressure canner, the experimental canning shows.

This is because the pressure saucan heats quickly, takes only a minute to exhaust its air content, and cools rapidly after the jars of food are processed. In a regular pressure canner those periods are longer than in a pressure saucan and provide a greater share of the heat that sterilizes the food for safe keeping.

Following are the processing times for pints at 10 pounds pressure which are recommended, from this experimental work, when a pressure saucan is used:

Asparagus—48 minutes; lima beans—58; snap beans—43; carrots—43; cream style corn—108; whole kernel corn—78; okra—48; peas—83; cubed pumpkin—78; spinach—88; summer squash—53; dry-pack sweet potatoes—88; wet pack sweet potatoes—78.
