British OK Proposal On German Unit

LONDON, June 7 (AP)—The British cabinet studied and quickly approved today the six-nation proposals on Germany, a government source said.

In France, the government faced a storm over the agreement, but foreign ministry aides predicted the national assembly will approve the pact after hearing many hot words. French opposition came from right and left alike—from Gen. Charles De Gaulle's chief adviser and from communist organs, speaking of a "national disaster."

The text of a six-nation agreement on Germany was handed Marshal Vassily D. Sokolovsky, Soviet military governor for that occupied country in Berlin, by the American

It aims at Germany's economic and political reconstruction. The Moscow radio yesterday quoted Pravda as saying the six-nation agreement "will never be recognized as lawful by peace-loving peoples whose interests were grossly trodden underfoot. . . . It will not be recognized by the German people either."

The Soviet Union has objected that in drawing up the plan, the western powers have broken the Potsdam agreement for Big Four divisions on Germany.

Yesterday in Paris, Gen. Charles De Gaulle's chief adviser, Gaston Palewski, said the government has abandoned French security in making the agreement.

Boeing Firing Supervisors

SEATTLE, June 7 (AP)—The Boeing Airplane company said Saturday supervisory employees who did not return to work after the start of the aero mechanics' union strike April 22 are being dismissed.

The company said they represent a "minor portion" of the more than 800 supervisory workers on the payroll.

A company statement said: "Following the strike, the major portion of supervision identified itself with management and remained at work. Those who did not remain were given the choice of returning to their supervisory responsibilities or being terminated as supervision and casting their lot with the striking union."

The company said rank-and-file union members are unaffected by the order. About 14,800 members of the union are on strike in a wage and seniority dispute.

'Egbert' To Be Guest Of Scientists

NEW YORK, June 7 (AP)—"Egbert," who met an untimely death about 62,000 years ago in what now is Lebanon, is in New York City.

During his stay, he may provide information on man's development. "Egbert," the skeleton of a boy about eight years old, arrived yesterday aboard the Marine Corp. along with 140 cases of other specimens dug up by archeologists at Ksar Akil, in the Antelias valley north of Beirut.

He was accompanied by the Rev. Joseph Murphy of Lexington, Mass., a member of the Boston college-Fordham university expedition to Lebanon which has been excavating at Ksar Akil since 1937.

"Egbert" was named by the Rev. J. Franklin Ewing of Fordham, head of the expedition. He was found in 1938, 45 feet deep in the excavation of a natural rock shelter.

Father Murphy said scientists hope the skeleton will give them information about mankind's physical development from homo neanderthalis—with his sloping forehead and jutting brows—to homo sapiens, modern man.

The skeleton is embedded in a

concrete-like mixture of clay, rock and other rubble. It will be shipped to Harvard university.

When the scientists have finished their studies, "Egbert" will go back to Lebanon, to stay in the national museum there.

Owens, a republican, was serving his first term. He had specialized in labor law and won a place on the house labor and education committee when he came to congress. He was active in framing the Taft-Hartley labor act.

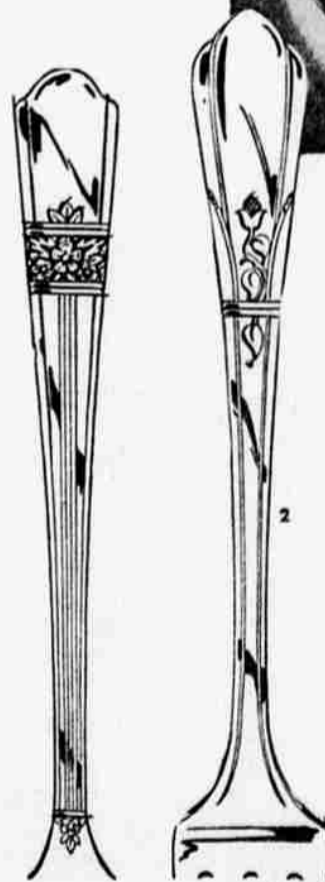
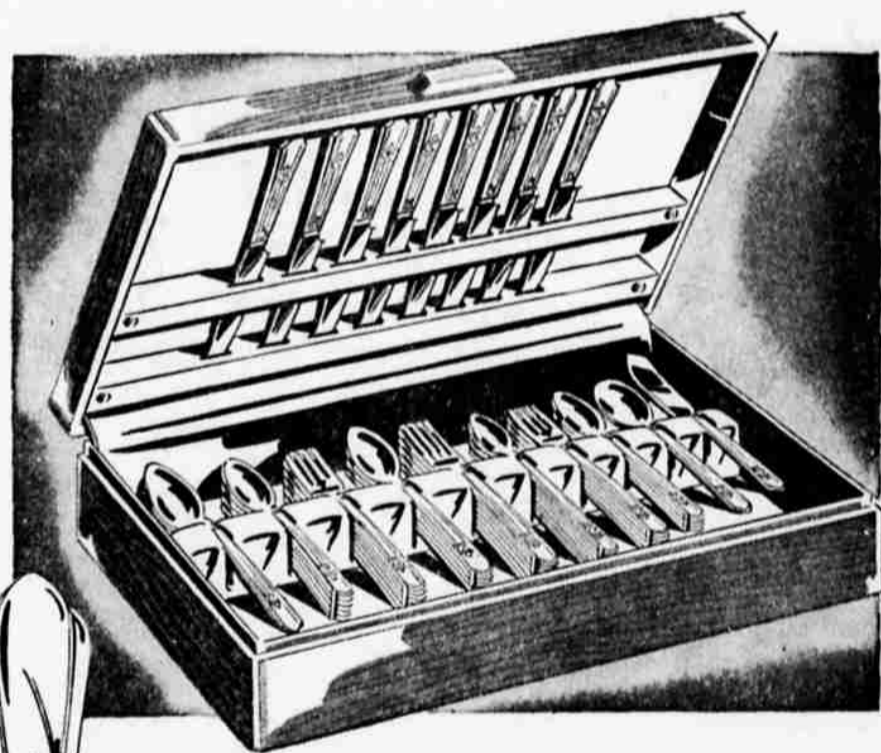
