

North Road Job Speeded

Sidewalk superintendents are getting a break these days with Rogers Construction company operating two shifts on the north entrance projects.

This gives the fathers plenty of time to saunter over after dinner and watch the huge dirt movers go noisily but efficiently about their business.

Work has progressed on building the grade to a point between Del Moro and LeRoy. Warm weather has made it possible to work the two shifts from daylight to dark and the last time due to wet weather is now being made up.

As soon as the grade is built up, crews will start concrete curbs in the vicinity of Portland street and along Alameda, the state highway advised today.

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph company has a crew laying a vitrified tile conduit in the vicinity of the Esplanade span over the government canal, laying it to approach on either side. There will be no connection of the conduit until the new bridge is completed, however, and this work will not start until water is out of the canal in late fall.

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22 Synagogues In Holy Land Blasted

JERUSALEM, June 9 (Delayed) (AP)—Dr. Isaac Halevy Herzog, chief rabbi of Palestine, said Monday that 22 of 27 synagogues in Jerusalem's old city were destroyed between May 17 and May 28.

He told a news conference this figure was based on the testimony of rabbis who came out of the old city, now in the hands of the Arabs. He added: "It is believed that the last five synagogues also were set on fire after the Jews left the old city."

Historic Elm Is Used For Gavel

BERKELEY SPRINGS, W. Va., June 9 (AP)—An historic elm which legend says was planted by George Washington yielded Tuesday the wood for three gavel which will be used at the republican national convention in Philadelphia.

The elm stands in Berkeley Springs state park and is said to have been planted by Washington sometime between 1748 and 1784.

School Heads Hold Meeting

Bus Company To Build Terminal

MEDFORD, June 9 (AP)—Contract for construction of a new Pacific Greyhound lines terminal here has been awarded to Donald M. Drake company, Portland.

The terminal has been listed as a \$125,000 structure. It is to be ready for use in September or early October.

F. W. Ackerman, president of the Pacific Greyhound lines, said the terminal is in addition to a \$46,000 maintenance garage under construction.

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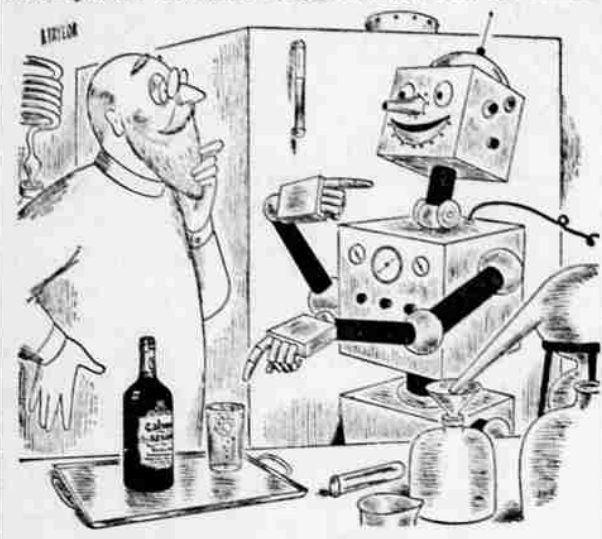
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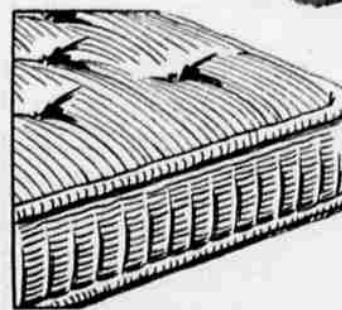
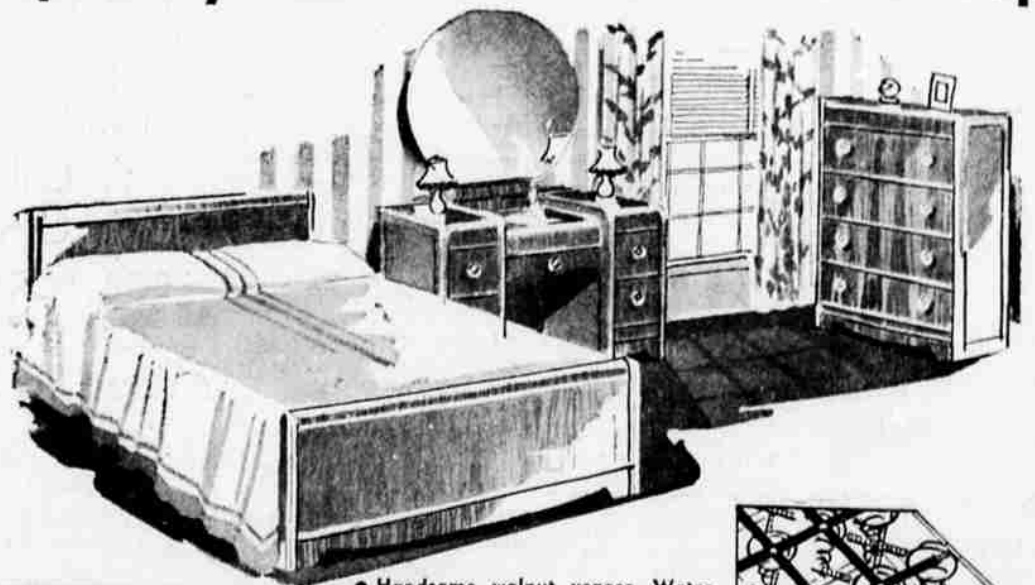


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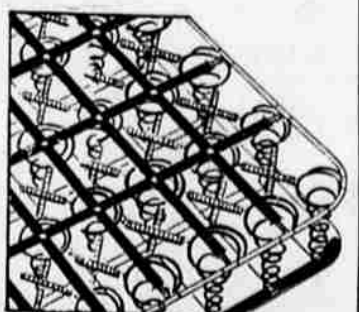
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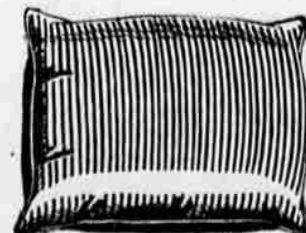
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
