

Bus Service To Alaska Now Possibility

SEATTLE, June 10 (AP)—Like a bus trip to Alaska? The service is available up the Alaska highway now.

Northwest Greyhound Lines, in a letter to its agents, suggests, however that travelers be advised not to wear their best clothes.

A Northwest Greyhound official explained tonight that the line does not operate to Alaska; it only sells tickets for the trip. Greyhound buses carry passengers to Eastport, Idaho. Western Canadian Greyhound carries them on to Edmonton, Alta.

From there, the company official said: "The service is disconnected.

That means you travel by day and stop over by night. The passenger must pay for his own meals and rooms along the route.

Canadian Coachways takes the travelers to Dawson Creek. Another Canadian carrier fills the gap into Yukon territory. From Whitehorse, both O'Hara and University bus lines operate into Alaska.

The fare to Fairbanks is \$116.00, plus tax and plus room and board along the way. It's \$140.60 to Anchorage on the same basis.

The Greyhound officials said reports to date in this first month of operation have shown the bus service running on schedule.

Fire Chased, But Out Now

DECATUR, Ill., June 10 (AP)—Firemen spent 10 minutes chasing a fire before they put it out last night. They made it on the fourth try.

The fire was in an empty freight car on an Illinois Central train. By the time the fire engine got to an intersection where the train had been, it had moved on.

The firemen backtracked a block, sped two blocks parallel to the tracks, and dashed down another side street to the railroad intersection.

By the time they got there, the burning car had passed that point. They made two more similar

trips before they caught up with the fire.

The train's crew, meanwhile, knew of the blaze, but didn't know the fire engine was chasing the train. They had kept the train moving, looking for a side street with a fire hydrant.

The freight car's sides were burned up. The firemen were a little hot, too.

ASTORIA TO SLASH CITY BUDGET

ASTORIA, June 10 (AP)—Astoria's city manager is drafting a budget which will cut all city departments' funds by 18 per cent during the next fiscal year.

The cut was forced by the voters' rejection of a proposed \$50,000 levy. A suggestion that water department funds be used for operating expenses proved impossible. The city attorney said that money is needed to pay interest.

Solons Agree On Navy Bill

WASHINGTON, June 10 (AP)—Senate and House conferees agreed Wednesday on a \$209,782,903 navy public works bill, including a controversial \$12,000,000 airfield for the Annapolis naval academy.

The legislation is expected to go to the Senate floor for a vote this afternoon, with House action later this week.

Senate representatives agreed to all changes made in the bill as passed by the House a week ago.

The legislation passed by the Senate previously provided about \$250,000,000 and did not include the airfield for indoctrination flight training of cadets at Sandy Point, near Annapolis.

The bill includes \$84,000,000 for installations at Guam, including a \$25,000,000 hospital for use by all of the armed services, a \$16,191,000 new base at Adak, Alaska, and \$6,718,700 for installations at Hawaii.

Of the total, \$91,949,950 is for construction in the United States and the remainder for projects outside the continental limits.

Other major items include a \$30,000,000 air missile test center at Point Mugu, Calif., and a \$3,670,-

500 ordinance test station at Inyokern, Calif.
