

# GOP Leaders Gird For Hot Battle To Prevent Action On Truman Farm Program

WASHINGTON, June 24 (AP)—A group of republicans girded Thursday for a fight against even a "trial run" for the Truman administration's new farm program.

The battle may echo in next year's congressional campaign in farm areas.

A house agriculture subcommittee Wednesday approved a 6 to 3 a new farm bill that would:

1. Permit Secretary of Agriculture Brannan to experiment on three crops in 1950 with his proposed "production payment" farm program. Brannan contends his program would mean cheaper food and assured income for farmers.
2. Kill the 1948 Alken law, which is scheduled to set up next year a flexible 60 to 90 per cent of parity price support program for agriculture. Parity is a price level set arbitrarily some years ago as a standard considered fair to both farmers and consumers.
3. Create a new parity-of-farm income system, as proposed by Brannan, and support prices of major crops at 100 per cent of that standard. This might mean for most crops the highest price supports ever attempted by the government.

Prices of crops are now supported at 90 per cent of the old parity standard.

Rep. August H. Andersen (R-Minn.), a top-ranking member of the agriculture committee, told newsmen:

"This thing has been reduced pretty much to a political matter, with the democrats trying to put through this Brannan thing."

"We will fight it in the full committee and on the floor. You will find republicans pretty much together in the house on continuing the present 90 per cent program and suspending the Alken law so we can have time to work out a real program."

The bill approved by the subcommittee went before the full committee Thursday.

Brannan has indicated he would like to try out the "production payment" plan first on hogs, potatoes and wool. The subcommittee banned any experimenting with wool, milk or butterfat, but gave him a clear field otherwise.

Under the production payments proposal, prices of perishable crops would be permitted to drop to whatever the market would pay. Then the government would pay subsidies to farmers to make up the difference between the market price and the parity-of-income level. This Brannan contended, would mean cheaper food and a fair return for farmers.

The plan has been attacked by some farm organizations as a "dole."

# Solon Asks Water Cost Adjustment

Congressman Lowell Stockman of the second district of Oregon has introduced a bill to approve amendatory repayment contracts negotiated with the Westland Irrigation district, the Stanfield Irrigation district and the Vale, Oregon, Irrigation district.

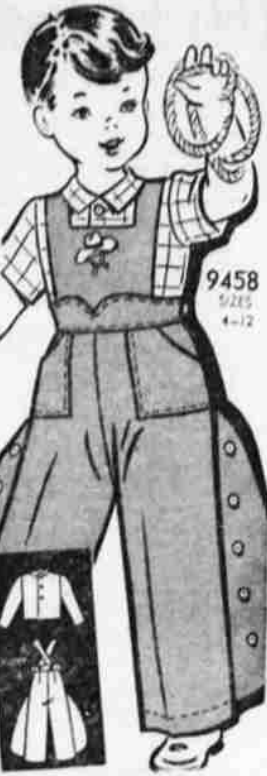
Congressman Stockman stated: "The purpose of the legislation is to authorize the secretary of the interior to execute contracts on behalf of the United States to adjust the water charges so they will be within the annual payment ability of the farmers. The contract with the Westland Irrigation district, near Hermiston, was approved by the electors of the district on May 14, and the contract with the Stanfield Irrigation district was approved by the electors on May 21, while the Vale contract was approved on April 11. The matter has been held up by the bureau of the budget, but I hope approval and congressional action can be obtained before the end of the session."

The bureau of reclamation, using authority granted to them in the reclamation project act of 1939, has made a detailed analysis of the physical and economic resources of the irrigation districts. These reports were reviewed in detail with the water users, and full agreement has been reached concerning the present and prospective payment ability of the lands of these districts. The proposed contracts are planned to protect both the interest of the government and the project water users.

# Tribesmen Give OK To White Queen

JOHANNESBURG, South Africa, June 24 (AP)—Hamangwato tribesmen defied their regent Thursday and voted overwhelmingly to accept a white queen.

She is Ruth Williams, a former London typist who married the chief-designate of the tribe, Seretse Khama, last October.

After three days of complicated ritualistic conferences at their capital, Serowe, Bechuanaland, only about a fifth of the 9000 pow-wowing natives voted against accepting Seretse and his white wife as their leaders. Seretse is 27 and his wife is 24.

Earlier in the day the aged regent, Tshekedi Khama, told the gathering: "The white woman is unsuitable to Seretse and the tribe. I will hand over the throne to him, but if he brings his white wife I will fight him to the end."

The regent had attempted to lay down the law but was overruled on a vote by a show of hands.

Since Tuesday the tribesmen have been discussing whether Seretse should rule them. Speaker after speaker arose before the throng gathered under the thorn trees of Serowe to denounce the marriage.

Seretse went to London four years ago to study law at Oxford university. While in Britain he married 24-year-old Ruth Williams, a former typist, without getting permission from the tribe's elders. Seretse's wife said after their marriage last October that she hoped to go to Africa to help him rule. Seretse and his wife are living in London.

The Hamangwato tribe is one of three important tribal groups in the British South African protectorate of Bechuanaland. Seretse is the son of Sekgoma, who died in 1929.
