

### Big Family Elects Board Of Directors, Holds Meet

SEATTLE, June 24 (AP)—Here's a family that's grown so large it elects a board of directors and holds an annual family reunion.

It's the Rinehart family, which currently is holding a three-day "convention" at Idylwild park at nearby Lake Sammamish.

Old-timers among the family will tell you it all started back in 1748 when the Rinehart brothers—Robert and Lewis—arrived in North Carolina from Germany.

They little knew what they'd started. But by the time branches of the family had moved westward, first to the Tennessee hills, and later by wagon train to Oregon territory, there were Rineharts from coast to coast.

Three hundred and five invitations were sent out for this year's get-together. Ninety showed up, the others being unable to make the trip.

W. E. Wilkins of The Dalles Ore., historian for the family, says it's the largest family in the nation to hold a three-day gathering.

"There's one larger family—the Ellises—in Pennsylvania," he said, "but they only hold a one-day annual meeting, which makes us champions of some sort."

It's a big operation, this Rinehart roundup.

"We have our own equipment," says Elwood R. Rinehart, this year's vice president, and proprietor of

a delegation to the United Nations, Dulles said.
