## State Puts Wine On New Basis

PORTLAND, June 27 (AP)—Wines sold through the state liquor control commission will be priced at the same level as in retail stores.

So ruled the commission Wednesday, in a measure designed to avoid competition with private firms.

The commission wrote final to the wartime distillery purchase, with a formal order ending the trusteeships over the Shawhan and Waterfall and Frazier distilleries. Those plants were bought by Oregon and Washington during the whiskey shortage.
