

Royal Observers Accuse British Press Of Faults, But Sees No Corruption

LONDON, June 30 (AP)—A royal commission criticized the British press Wednesday for partisanship, distortion of news and failure to give a clear picture of world affairs.

It recommended setting up a general council of the press to foster—but not force—integrity and responsibility to the public.

At the same time, the report—issued after two years' study—declared "it is generally agreed that the British press is inferior to none in the world. It is free from corruption."

The commission, whose report is addressed to the king and presented also to parliament and the government, has no power to put any of its recommendations into practice. Its findings, however, are expected to give authoritative guidance to the government in dealing with press matters. The commission secretary said it hoped the survey would stimulate public discussion.

The commission suggested that its proposed general council of the press should have a minimum of 25 members.

The members would include eight representing proprietors of newspapers, periodicals and principal news agencies; four editors, eight other journalists, four lay members and a chairman.

In addition to safeguarding freedom of the press and encouraging a sense of responsibility and public service among all engaged in journalism, the council would:

- Keep watch on any restrictions on the flow of public information.
- Improve methods of recruitment, education and training for journalists.
- Censure undesirable journalistic conduct.
- Look into a comprehensive pension plan.
- Promote technical and other research.
- Study developments which tend toward greater concentration or monopoly.
- Represent the press in relations with the government, United Nations organizations or press organizations abroad.

The commission said most newspapers support some political party. "Their treatment of public affairs is, in consequence, partisan," the commission continued.

"... In most papers a study of the news columns alone would leave few readers in doubt about their political sympathy.

"Partisanship is present in some degree in all the papers. It is generally pronounced in the popular press; it is much less marked in some, but not all, of the quality papers...

"The press is a part of our political machinery, which is essentially partisan. But partisanship can and does on occasion lead to a degree of selection and coloring of news which can only be regarded as excessive."

Gus Solomon Named For Judgeship

PORTLAND, June 30 (AP)—Gus J. Solomon, 42, Portland attorney, is the official nominee of Oregon Democrats for the proposed third federal judgeship in Oregon.

He won the endorsement yesterday of Monroe Sweetland, democratic national committeeman, and Nancy Honeyman Robinson, national committeewoman.

Under recently established state party rules, the choice is up to these two. They sent their endorsements to President Truman and Sen. J. Howard McGrath, chairman of the democratic national committee.

Solomon was a Truman supporter last year. He has been an active democrat.

Sweetland said Hall S. Luak, chief justice of the state supreme court, and Circuit Judge Earl C. Latourrette, Oregon City, were considered, but then eliminated because of "an unwritten policy which prefers the appointment of men under 60 years of age."

Sweetland added that Henry L. Hess, La Grande, U. S. attorney for Oregon, also was eliminated because he is from eastern Oregon, the same district that produced Oregon's present two federal judges. Western Oregon now needs representation, Sweetland said.

He added that W. L. Joslin, state democratic chairman, made known his candidacy too late for consideration.

The third federal judgeship is being considered in a bill now before congress.
