

Guy Fletcher Wings No. 15 In Padre Win

Seattle Flinger Heads Hurlers; Sacs Stop Bevov

This year the Pacific Coast league should have an ample supply of 20-game winners.

Today the PCL pitching parade—headed in 1948 by Red Lynn, ex-Los Angeles, with a mere 19 games—was topped by Seattle's Guy Fletcher with 15 wins, just past the season's halfway point.

Fletcher racked up No. 15 last night in twirling the Rainiers to a 6-2 decision over San Diego. The veteran right-hander has lost only four and bids strongly to post the best record of any Seattle pitcher since Freddy Hutchinson's 25 and 7 in 1938.

Fletcher spaced 11 Padre hits as his mates bunched most of their six hits in the fourth and eighth innings for clusters of three and two runs off Lyman Lunde. Hills Layne's homer with one on was the big blow.

Other prospective 20-game winners include Fletcher's teammate, Charley Schanz, who has won 13; Frank Dasso, Sacramento, 13; Gordon Malachuk and Pinky Woods of Hollywood, 11; Jess Flores, San Diego, 10; Glenn Moulder and Willard Ramsdell of Hollywood, 10.

Ramsdell, the wily knuckleballer, registered his 10th last night with a 5-1 conquest of Oakland. It was a flossy seven-hit job and a shutout until the ninth when two singles and an infield out pushed across an Acorn run. Percentage-wise Ramsdell is the PCL kingpin. He has lost but two.

Hollywood's four-run blast off Rex Cecil in the fifth, however, featured by Jim Hanzel two-run double, kept the Stars seven games ahead of Seattle.

Booker McDaniels, who might have been a 20-game candidate with an earlier start, pitched his fourth straight triumph since joining Los Angeles. The dark angel beat San Francisco, 5-3, after a shaky start.

Rookie Tom Rose got robust batting support as Sacramento stopped Portland, 7-4. Rose checked the Beavers with nine assists, while Joe Marly sparked the Stars' 14-hit assault with four for four, including a homer and a double good for three runs.

Good Fishing Predicted Prospects Rosy In Lane, Deschutes

PORTLAND, July 1 (AP)—Oregonians going fishing over the Fourth of July holiday should have good luck in Lane county and in the Deschutes country.

That was the prediction of the state game commission in its weekly fishing bulletin. The outlook of districts:

Douglas county—Reedsport—striped bass fishing improving in lower Umpqua near Reedsport. Salmon anglers are getting Chinooks at Winchester bay.

Klamath county—Streams fair. Klamath lake and Lake of the Woods good.

Diamond lake—Fair. Few fish taken on files.

Deschutes county—Prospects for week-end good. All lakes reporting good catches. Upper Deschutes river water in good condition, catches fair; Metolius river—Excellent catches reported. Lower Deschutes area—water still slightly higher and success just fair.

Odele lake—Trotting for large Mackinaw and dollops fair. Fly fishing poor due to cold weather. Crescent lake—Trotting for rainbows good. Gold lake—Dry fly fishing poor, trolling flies producing fair catches. Davis lake—Nice catches of big Rainbow continue to be taken on trolled streamer flies, dry fly fishing poor. Marily and Rosary groups are fair to poor. Midnight lake only fair. Crescent creek and Marsh creek have been fair for bait or flies. Upper Little Deschutes is fair to good. Warmer weather will improve fishing in this entire area.
