Hotel Fire Claims Seven

ABERDEEN, July 5 (AP)—An elderly woman hurried back into the blazing Lafayette hotel early Sunday to recover her purse and her lifetime savings of approximately \$2000.

She was trapped by the roaring, fast-spreading flames and she and six others all perished. She was Mrs. Eliza Beahm. Police and coroner's deputies found the roll of scorched currency in her purse yesterday after first reports that she had had only \$48.77.

The injured persons, including FPC Jerry F. Hamner, 18, Olympia, were recovering. The burned-out hollow shell of the two-story building in which 22 persons lived was hoisted up. Those who escaped got out on ladders or jumped to an adjoining roof.

No definite cause of the fire had been determined.
The dead: Mrs. Beahm, Mrs. Mary Kearns, 74; Mrs. Mary Abshire, Hugh Rogers, a paralytic; Paul Myhr, hotel proprietor; and Mr. and Mrs. Earl Christofferson, South Bend.

Fire Rips Hotels At Revere Beach

REVERE, Mass., July 5 (AP)—A fierce fire wrecked two hotels, 24 waterfront cottages and 19 automobiles at Revere Beach—the Coney Island of New England—last night.
Fire Chief Thomas J. McCarrack estimated damage at \$125,000.
The flames, apparently originating in a large garage, jumped swiftly to the three-story Hotels Chateau Thierry and Seaview and the small cottages. Most of the automobiles destroyed belonged to bathers seeking relief from 100-degree temperatures.

Banks Report Deposits Down

In answer to the June 30 call of the comptroller of currency, the Klamath Falls branch of the First National bank of Portland reports deposits of \$14,739,055.19 and loans of \$9,249,968.97. In charge of the local bank is R. H. Tidale, manager.
A year ago the figures were, deposits, \$17,443,120.53, and loans, \$9,421,055.19, Tidale said.

The S. 8th street, Klamath Falls branch of the First National bank of Portland reports deposits of \$833,832.79 and loans of \$143,875.57. In charge of the local bank is Myron E. Shannon, manager.

On December 31, 1948, a few days after the branch opened, the figures were, deposits, \$415,363.18, and loans, \$699.00, Shannon said.

President F. N. Belgrano Jr. stated that for the First National group of 61 banking offices, as a whole, the June 30 statement shows loans of \$12,297,729.97, and deposits of \$54,824,548.94. A year ago, with 56 banking offices in the group, the figures were, deposits, \$572,979,049.71, and loans, \$163,875,390.13.

President Belgrano pointed out that the decrease in deposits since June 30, 1948 reflects the readjustment of business to a more normal level and the slackening of the post-war surge of consumer buying and are in line with a nationwide trend.

GUARDS

All Malin children who wish to take lessons are asked to register Thursday morning, July 7, between 9 a. m. and 12 noon, at the pool. Merrill and Tulelake residents may register in their home towns.

The classes will be under the supervision of the American Red Cross. At the end of the course, those passing will receive certificates of merit.

A schedule is being worked out now, and the date for the beginning of classes will be announced in a few days.

Ward Stone has been hired to manage the pool. He will be assisted by Arlie Mae Johnson and Hazel Gift. All three have been trained by the Red Cross. The course will run for about a month.

MOSCOW, July 5 (AP)—Andrei Gromyko, Soviet deputy foreign minister, attended Independence Day celebrations at the American embassy here.

Laughing, joking, and in obvious good spirits, the Russian diplomat joined the new American ambassador, Alan G. Kirk, in toasts to Soviet-American friendship.

Kirk yesterday presented his credentials to Soviet President Nikolai Shvernik and pledged to "work unflinchingly to better relations existing between our two nations."

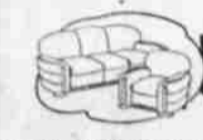
