Harold Runnels Drives Winner In Soapbox Derby

Before the interested gaze of around 500 spectators, radio royalty and Reno Browne, visiting celebrity, Harold Runnels drove his "soapbox" car over the finish line to first place in the 20-30 club derby Saturday.

Gene Carroll sped into second place. Bill Weybrandt made third and David Stewart wheeled his vehicle into fourth as the 18 contestants vied for honors on the Upham street slope, finishing at California street. Two cars at a time were raced and only one minor casualty occurred—that was when Eddie Moore's car overturned, ruining his chance to win.

Entries were limited to boys between the ages of 11 and 14 inclusive and each of them had sponsors. Most of the boys identified their vehicles with the names of their sponsors who had furnished wheels and lumber for construction.

Troops Unload Struck Ships

LONDON, July 6 (AP)—The labor government ordered troops into the London waterfront tonight to unload food ships paralyzed by a strike of stevedores.

The two weeks strike continued to spread today despite a threat by United States dock workers to boycott British ships there unless it stops.

Most of the more than 100 cargo ships harbor-locked by the Thames river strike carry food for rationed Londoners. Labor Minister George Isaacs told parliament the government had decided to use troops as a means of "safeguarding food supplies."

Survey Made Of Site For Industries

The city police judge's office has just completed an extensive survey of undeveloped property in railroad and second railroad additions, with an eye toward developing the land into an industrial or semi-industrial area.

The survey was taken in the district bordered by Commercial, Oak Spring and Sixth, and 243 vacant lots, privately owned, were said to be undeveloped but revealed definite possibilities as a good industrial site.

The survey was suggested by Councilman Wendell Smith during a recent council session, and approved by the council body.

AFL Millmen Go Back On The Job

PORTLAND, July 6 (AP)—AFL millmen who have been idle for two months were back on the job today in 32 woodworking plants scattered throughout the state.

A union official said the 1000 workers were called back subject to a ratification vote on an employer wage offer.

The union spokesman said the wage offer of 6 to 7 cents an hour more would boost the general scale to \$1.85 an hour.
