

Census Checkers Already Working On Big 1950 Job

WASHINGTON — The big 1950 census doesn't start until next April, but don't be surprised if a census man calls at your home this summer.

Every month census bureau enumerators visit about 25,000 households in the United States. They ask questions about the age, marital status and employment of members of households.

The employment census on which the bureau bases its estimate of the number of job-holders and job-hunters, is now raised more important than the count of population. Employment information is valuable to the government and private industry as an indicator of business conditions.

Some householders resent the questioning as "prying into private affairs." A few others are scared by it in these days of agitation over communists and charges of disloyalty.

Census bureau officials say people have nothing to fear from the interviewers. The information is strictly confidential as far as the individual householder or his family is concerned.

Names of individuals are not sent to Washington headquarters. The information received here is used only for compiling the number of employed and unemployed and other statistics.

Not even the FBI or internal revenue collectors can obtain census information for investigation or tax collecting purposes. Federal law prohibits its use except in statistics.

Some people refuse to cooperate with the census bureau's enumerators or interviewers. However, relatively few persist in refusing after the interviewers have shown identification cards with their photographs and have explained why the information is being collected.

Cleanliness Is New Red Aim

MOSCOW (AP)—A widespread movement has developed in the Soviet Union for cleanliness and order at work. It was initiated by workers and has been reported and propagandized by the Soviet press.

Articles appearing on this subject emphasize that in factories good order and cleanliness in shops is associated with high productivity of labor. At the same time that cleanliness is propagandized the press emphasizes the importance of economy of raw materials and parts, high productivity of equipment, and strict observation of technological systems.

A lead editorial in "Moscow Bolshevik" recently declared that every working place, every shop must from now on be kept at all times in model order and thoroughly clean.

THEATRES SUBSIDIZED

ROME (AP)—Italy with spend 229,947,000 lire (\$383,000) this year for subsidizing private theatrical companies. The amount is split in small subsidies varying from \$500 to \$3000 to some 80 companies and small theatres.

Of the amount 5,200,000 lire will be spent to support production of plays in local dialect. To encourage the companies to produce new plays by Italian authors, the undersecretary of state for theatres and tourism gave a bonus of \$500 to the companies which produced 17 new plays by Italian authors during the 1948-49 season.
