Demand For Stock Fades

NEW YORK, July 21 (AP)—Demand for stocks faded today and the price curve turned downward for the first time this week.

The decline, though, didn't get very far. Few issues slipped as much as a point.

Turnover was at the rate of around 800,000 shares for the full day, which would compare with 1,380,000 yesterday and 1,590,000 Tuesday.

Wall Street was not much concerned with today's break in a rally which has been under way—since mid-June.

Giving ground were Bethlehem Steel, Chrysler, Commonwealth & Southern, Kennecott Copper, General Electric, Eastman Kodak and Mision Corp.

Steadier stocks included Sears Roebuck, Lockheed, Western Union, American Woolen, and Transcontinental & Western Air.
