Czech Chief Swings Vote To Moscow

PRAGUE, Czechoslovakia, July 25 (AP)—Czechoslovakia's communist premier said yesterday that if forced to choose between Catholicism or communism, the country's answer would be: "Moscow, Stalin, socialism." Premier Antonin Zapotocky, speaking to 15,000 union members in Trutnov—formerly a part of the Sudetan German region—declared: "If the Pope today excommunicated all communists and with them all the co-operating, believing Christians, then we would be aware of the fact that he is excommunicating nearly the entire Czechoslovak working people." "Our people have found a real friend and ally in the east. We never posed ourselves the question, Rome or Moscow? However, if that question is placed to us through actions from the other side, then we shall leave nobody in doubt that the answer of our nation shall be that there is no other alternative for us but Moscow-Stalin-socialism."

Alaska Jail Scene Of Two Mystery Deaths

NOME, Alaska, July 25 (AP)—The hanging deaths of two city jail prisoners, one a young woman, puzzled city authorities today.

The body of the woman, Mrs. Georgianna Lott, about 25, was found hanging from her cell door late Saturday, about 45 minutes after her arrest.

A coroner's jury deliberated four hours, then ruled she had died at the hands of "a person or persons unknown."

Two days earlier another inmate, Alfred Blatchford, 23, was found hanging from the door of the "bull pen" where he had been locked up with several other prisoners. His death, a coroner's jury held after 18 hours' deliberation, was a suicide.

Both victims had been strangled by cloth strips from torn mattress covers.

Other men in the cell with Blatchford were questioned.

None had raised an outcry over his death. The group in the large tank included several miners charged with drunkenness.

Blatchford had been picked up about midnight Wednesday for fighting and disorderly conduct. Mrs. Lott was arrested and held without charge.
