WHEAT LEADS GRAIN MARKET

CHICAGO, July 27 (AP)—Wheat came to the front of an advancing grain market toward the close today, running up more than a cent on general commission house and local buying. The gains here followed an upturn at outside markets, particularly Minneapolis.

Until the last hour wheat had dragged along without getting anywhere. It opened lower and then recovered in sympathy with a firm corn trend. The latter grain showed some strength from the start, largely because of heavy impounding of cash corn under the government loan.

Wheat closed 1 to 1 1/2 higher, September \$2.05 1/2-3/4, corn was 1 1/4-1/2 higher, September \$1.28 1/2-3/4, oats were 1/2-3/4 higher, September 65 1/2, rye was 1/4-3/4 higher, September \$1.54 1/2-3/4, soybeans were 4 to 5 cents higher, November \$2.31-2.30, and lard was 12 to 15 cents a hundred pounds higher, September \$11.60.

NEW YORK, July 27 (AP)—The stock market barely maintained headway today.

Prices eased in a fractional price range, with gains and losses well scrambled.

Fairly active trading developed off and on, helped along by a couple of large deals in Commonwealth and Southern. Turnover was at a rate of about 1,000,000 shares for the full day.

U. S. Steel's dividend and earnings report, eagerly awaited by the market and issued after the close yesterday, affected neither the stock of the company or the market generally. Big Steel opened unchanged and varied only 1/4 point or so during the day.

Higher a good part of the day were Republic Steel, Goodyear, Montgomery Ward, Western Union, Kennecott, Dow Chemical, and Transcontinental and Western Air.

Sticky spots included Bethlehem Steel, Chrysler, Studebaker, Southern Pacific, and Twentieth Century-Fox.
