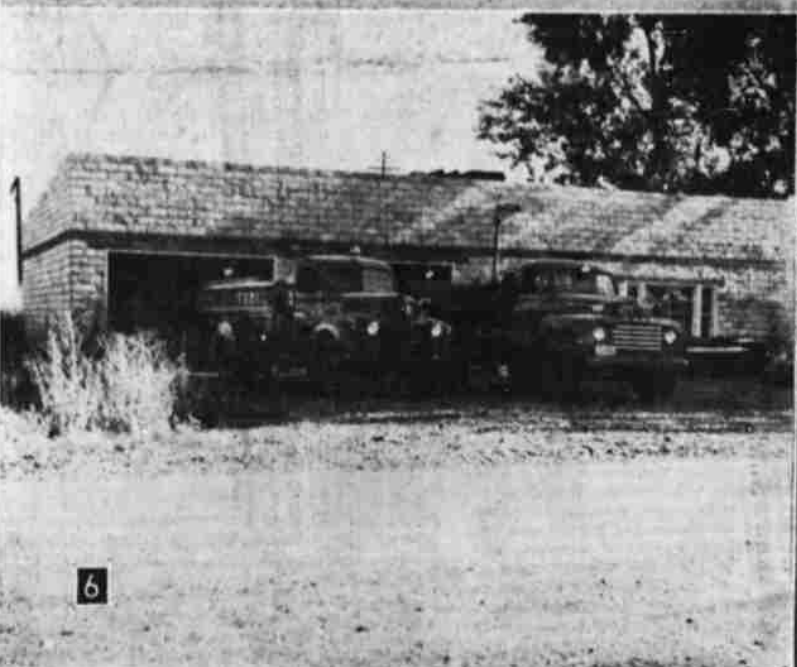
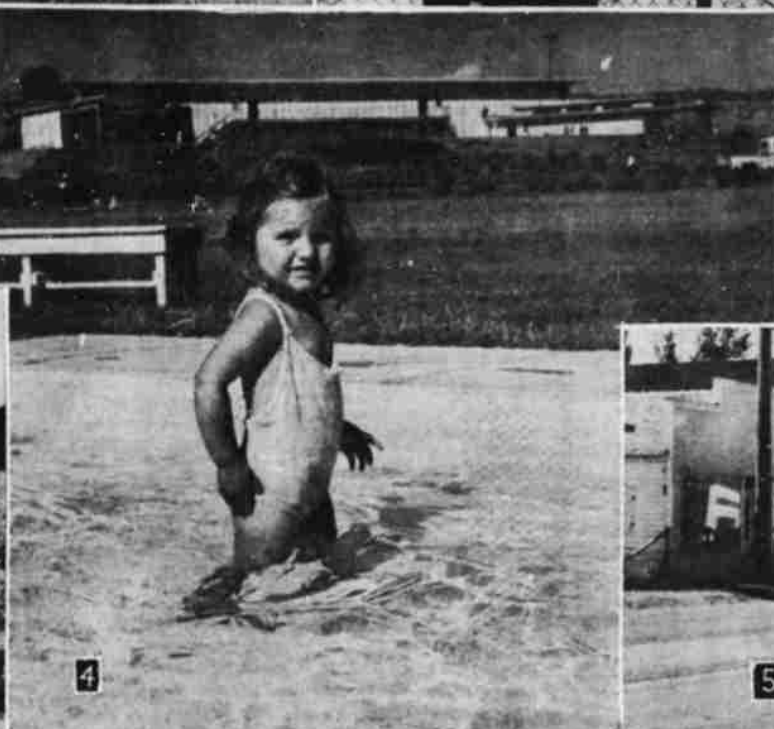
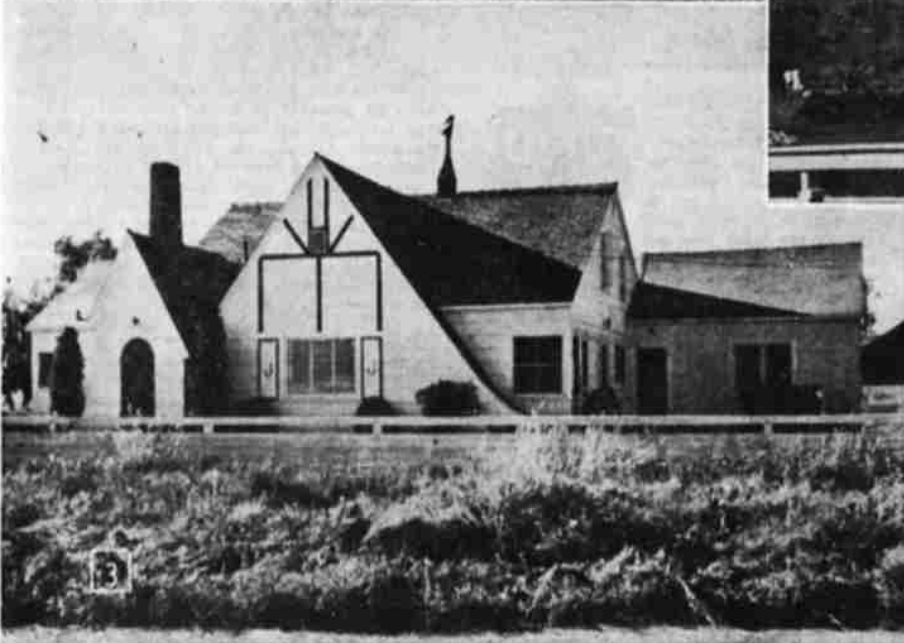
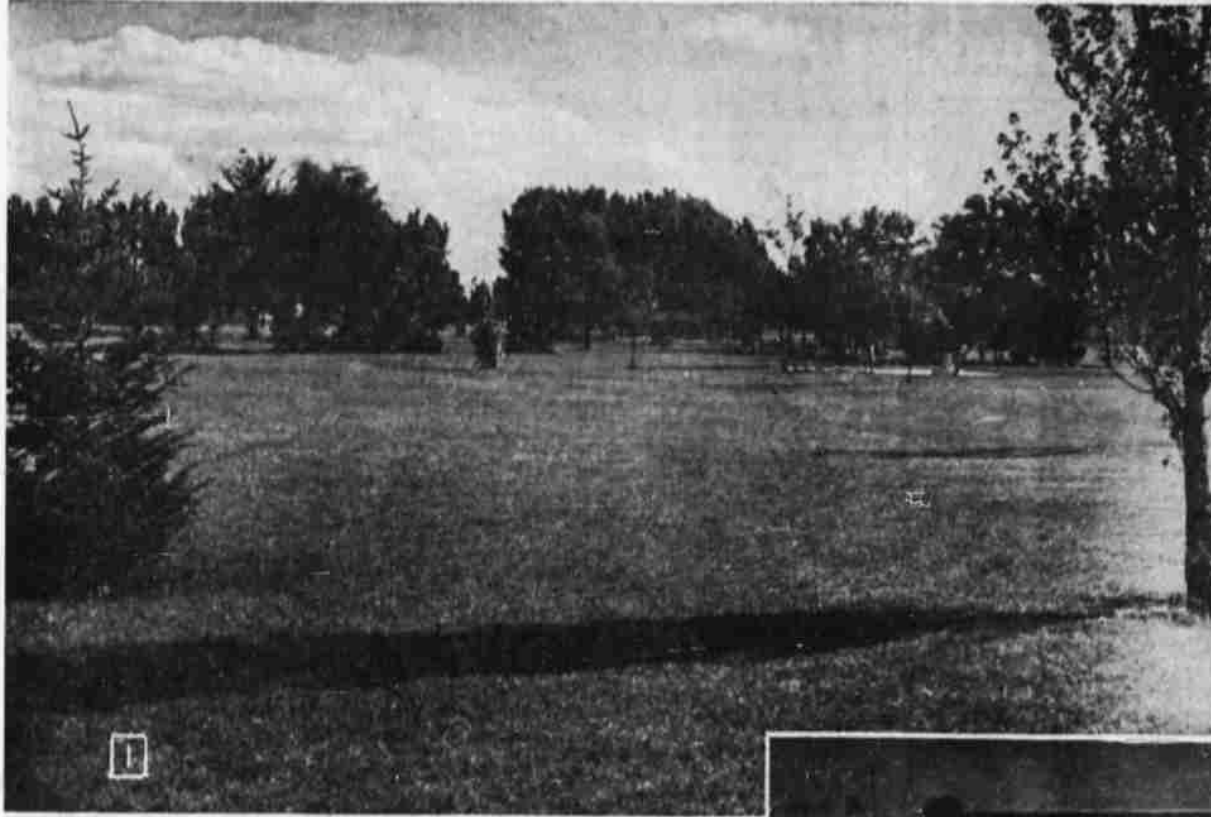


Klamath Salutes Malin, Builder of Outstanding Park, Swimming Pool, Center of Farming Area
