

Top Sears Personnel Pay Flying Visit To Klamath

The Sears Roebuck and company plane, "Pacific Coaster," a DC-3, roared to a landing on Klamath airport Wednesday morning with an exclusive passenger list, all top officials of the company.

This was the maiden flight of the specially equipped airplane through this territory and the seven passengers only made a short visit here looking over the local Sears store.

The visitors were met by a welcoming committee headed by Chamber of Commerce Manager Charles R. Stark and Aviation Committee Chairman Lawrence Blomster and included Mayor Bob Thompson, the four key men from the store here, H. B. Hartley, manager; Carl Williams, auditor; Gene Spencer, division head, and Daunt Jessop, credit manager.

As the passengers descended from the huge silver and blue ship, Stark stepped forward and presented A. T. Cushman, vice president of Sears and Roebuck, and company in charge of the Pacific coast, with a gift of welcome.

With Cushman were C. E. Bratby, in charge of personnel for the Pacific coast; W. H. Butkofer, credit manager for the Pacific coast; R. G. Curry, assistant secretary and Pacific coast regional auditor; Ralph Spencer, sales manager for the Pacific coast; S. E. Epstein in charge of promotions and distribution and assistant to Cushman; Nate Ash, in charge of the fashion department.

The visitors were rushed downtown from the airport, and lunch was ready for them on the plane when they returned. Crew of the plane consists of Vic Swanson, Sears

pilot, and Paul Carabelli, co-pilot, who handle the entire job. The plane is comfortably equipped with adjustable chairs, a lounge section, couches for the pilots and a kitchen. It is attractively decorated in a blue and grey color scheme and has the Sears "S" on frosted glass partitions.

The tour has come through Idaho, Washington and Oregon. The group left here for San Francisco for an overnight stop before going on to Los Angeles.

Chamber To Oppose Bills

Directors of the Klamath County chamber of commerce learned at their regular luncheon meeting on Wednesday of the calling for bids on a 23-mile section of the Denio-Winnemucca end of the Winnemucca-to-the-Sea highway and plans for sending a delegation from here to the celebration of the event to be held in Alturas were referred to the chamber's highway committee.

The directors voted to oppose senate bill 238 and house resolution 378, companion bills introduced in congress. 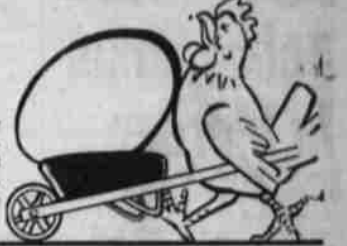
He requested a preliminary hearing at Judge J. A. Mahoney's justice court, but no date was set.
