

State Park Development Program To Be Outlined

PORTLAND, Aug. 2 (AP)—A thorough program of state park development was recommended Monday by State Highway Commission Chairman T. H. Banfield.

He asked the state highway parks superintendent, Sam Boardman, to prepare an overall plan of what improvements should be made in Oregon state parks and what the work should cost.

The matter came up when Boardman requested \$10,000 to permit the Wallowa lake channel to deepen launching of motorboats. The commission agreed to call for bids on the work, but asked for the general survey.

"What we need and want," said Banfield, "is a complete program of what is planned so we will know just how much money we can spend each year on these parks. We can't just go along spending some money here and there."

The park superintendent also recommended construction of overnight parking in Wallowa Lake, Emigrant Springs, Cove, Silver Falls, Sunset Bay and Wallowa Mountain parks.

The commission opened several bids today. The largest was a project to improve the highway between Seaside and Cannon Beach, Leonard & Slate, Portland, submitted the low bid of \$325,675 on the work, which includes 2.56 miles of grading and 1.37 miles of paving between the summit and Tolovana park.

Other low bids:

Jackson county: Provoit-Jacksonville section of Provoit-Medford secondary highway, 0.8 mile of surfacing and 1.14 miles of grading, M. C. Linniger & Son, Medford, \$36,817.

Marion county: Tunnel Creek culvert construction, R & M Construction Co., Central Point, \$9255.

Polk county: Dallas (Levens street) paving project, United Construction Co., \$8312.

Wallowa county: North unit, Enterprise-Poresty boundary section of Enterprise-Lewiston highway, Durbin Bros., Eugene, \$171,015.

Multnomah county: Landscaping three areas along S.W. Front avenue, Western Golf Course Supply Co., Portland, \$7233.

Medford Gets Air Reserve Headquarters

MEDFORD, Aug. 2 (AP)—Medford has been designated as headquarters for a volunteer air reserve training group that covers virtually all of Western, Southern and Central Oregon, officials announced today.

The new group, the 8901st, is composed of "thousands" of officers and men, the announcement said, from all counties in the state with the exception of those bordering on the Columbia river and the state of Idaho.

Commanding officer of the unit is Col. Elmer H. Stambaugh, Gold Hill, USAFB (Ret.).

Six squadrons make up the group. They include the 9412th squadron, Bend; 9413d squadron, Corvallis; 9414th squadron, Salem; 9415th squadron, Coos Bay; 9416th squadron, Eugene; 9417th squadron, Medford. They are commanded by air reserve officers.

Flights from the six squadrons are located in Redmond, Burns, Bend, Salem, McMinnville, Albany, Corvallis, Newport, Eugene, Cottage Grove, North Bend, Coos Bay, Roseburg, Grants Pass, Ashland, Klamath Falls and Medford.

Squadron commanders include Maj. Albert T. Lassen, Bend; Lt. Col. John H. Reardon, Corvallis; Lt. Col. Robert C. Irwin, Salem; Maj. Robert D. Shaw, Coos Bay; Lt. Col. Arthur H. Delmoor, Eugene, and Maj. John H. Enders, Medford.

Brannon Raps Farm Rejection

JUNEAU, Wis., Aug. 2 (AP)—Dairy farmers are not going to get adequate price protection and consumers are not going to get the dairy products they need under the farm bill recently selected by the house of representatives, dairymen were told Sunday.

Secretary of Agriculture Brannon passed on this prophecy in a speech in the heart of the midwest's dairyland. He criticized the house for rejecting his own farm plan.

The house measure, said Brannon, which would continue present farm price supports for another year, would assure dairymen an average of only \$3.53 for 100 pounds of milk. This is a level "so unrealistic" that it has little meaning, he told members of dairy co-operatives at their annual picnic.

His own plan, aimed at higher farm income and cheaper food, would support milk prices at an average of \$4.32.

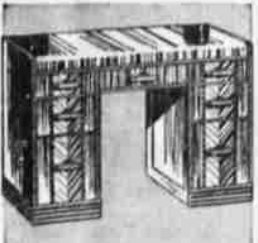
