

# Chiefs Back After Talks In Europe

WASHINGTON, Aug. 9 (AP)—The joint chiefs of staff returned today, ready to give congress the benefit of their 10-day conferences in Europe with Atlantic pact nations' military chiefs.

Gen. Omar N. Bradley, army chief of staff; Gen. Hoyt S. Vandenberg, air force chief of staff; and Adm. Louis Denfield, chief of naval operations, returned aboard President Truman's plane, the Independence. It landed at 6:30 a.m.

They will lunch with Defense Secretary Johnson. Tomorrow they are to appear before the senate armed forces committee.

**Good Start**

General Bradley described the conferences as "a grand start toward organizing the unity and collective security under the Atlantic pact."

Bradley said the objectives in making the trip "had two objectives: to inspect U. S. forces in Germany and Austria, and to discuss with the defense chiefs of Atlantic pact nations possible organization under the pact."

"We discussed several forms of organization," Bradley said. "But we didn't try to arrive at any decision."

Bradley said that the chiefs of the nations with whom they conferred "took our coming over so soon after passage of the Atlantic pact as an indication of our willingness to make it work."

He added: "We hoped that these frank discussions and exchanges of views will help our respective governments and will shorten conferences necessary to organize under the pact."

## Miner Given Fair Chance For Recovery

PORTLAND, Ore., Aug. 9 (AP)—An elderly man who was lost without food for 13 days was given a fair chance of recovery today.

Two rescuers who stubbornly refused to quit the search for John Harrison Tracy, 76, found him yesterday in a small hut in the mountain wilderness. Others had abandoned hope Tracy had survived.

Tracy, lying on his back and barely able to mumble a request for water, closed the hands of Ray Godleske and Ben Franklin when they picked him up. Foresters quickly organized a party and carried the emaciated miner four miles to the ambulance.

Harold E. Wooster reported his father-in-law had lost about 35 pounds. He said the elderly man had indicated he lay in the shelter for eight days. Hospital attendants here said he had a fair chance of recovering.

Tracy's car was found two days after he left home July 26. He had planned to retrace an old emigrant wagon trail along which he remembered his pioneer mother had once told him there was gold.

Godleske and Franklin will share a \$1000 reward offered by Tracy's relatives for finding him "dead or alive."

## Family Files To Force Union To Cease Action

PORTLAND, Aug. 9 (AP)—The Hughes family troubles with butcher union pickets have gone to court.

Joseph A. Hughes has asked for an injunction to stop the central labor council and the AFL meatcutters from picketing his meat and grocery market.

The father and family members are the only workers, he argued, and they shouldn't be required to join the union.

The dispute has been going on for nine months. He told the circuit court that truck drivers have refused to make deliveries and he has lost customers because of picketing.

Police have been called repeatedly to the market, where the Hughes family has picketed the union pickets and numerous disputes have followed.

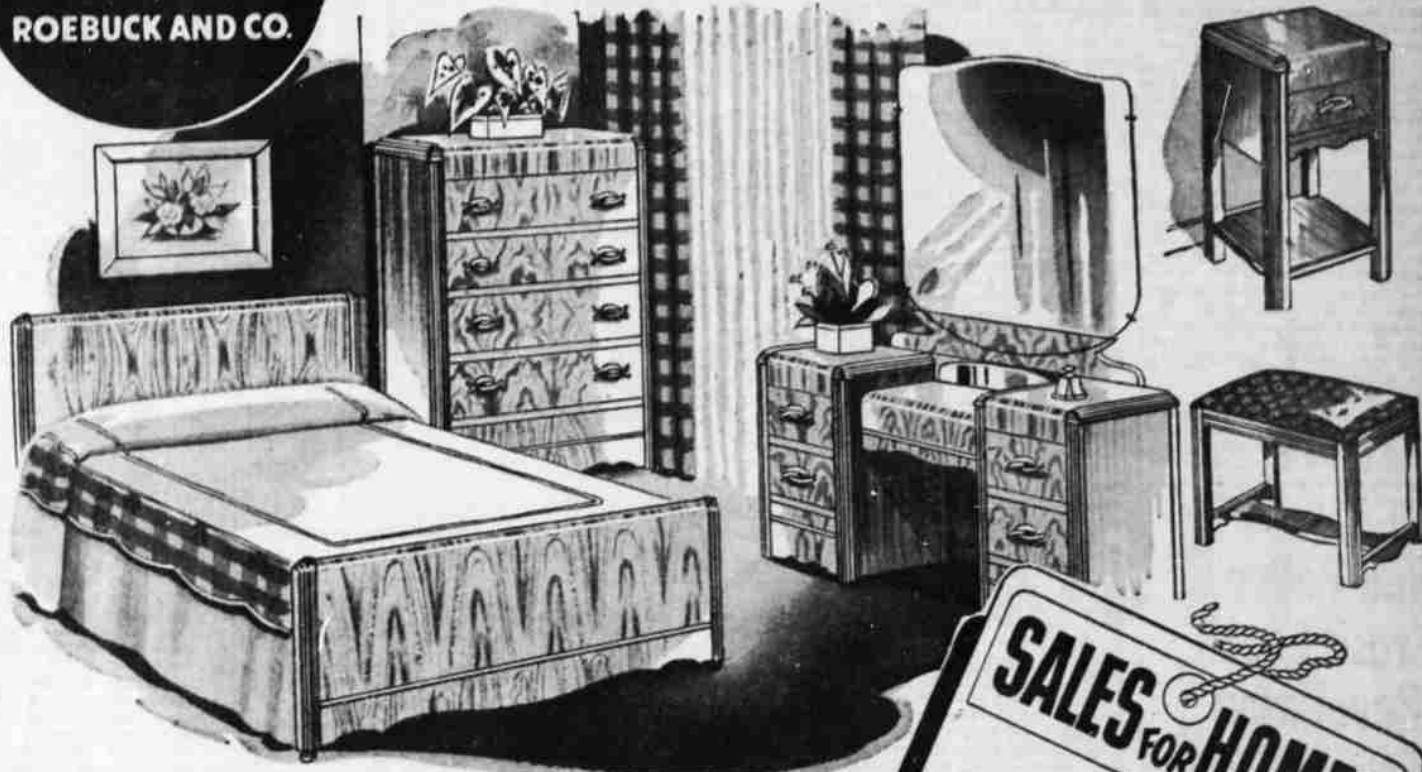

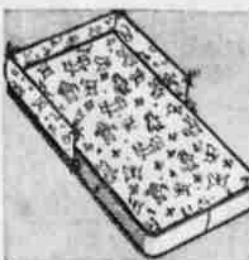

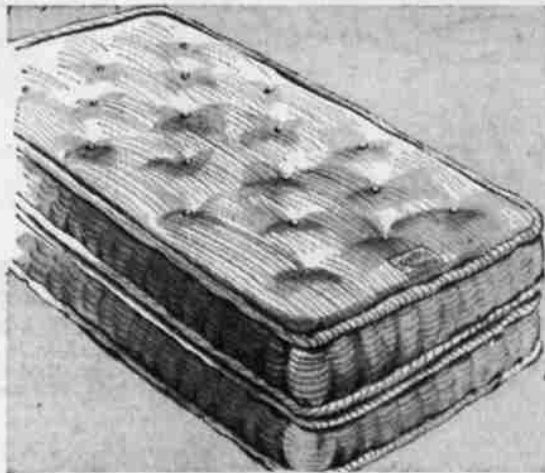
