

# Atom Power Seen Coming In Our Era

LONGVIEW, Aug. 15 (AP)—Rep. Henry M. Jackson (D-Wash.) promised yesterday that "in our lifetime we will see atomic power plants producing electric energy for industry, ships and trains and possibly airplanes."

The congressman spoke at the climax to the city's seafaring silver jubilee celebration.

Jackson, a member of the senate-house joint atomic energy committee, told celebrants that "we can take real satisfaction from the mounting stocks of fissionable materials... though these stockpiles are in the shape of weapons—the most deadly weapons ever made by man."

"But if and when the threat of war has ceased," he added, "there will come the deeper satisfaction—perhaps joy is the real word to use—of knowing that this same stockpile of weapons can be converted to peaceful applications benefiting all mankind."

The Everett congressman also disclosed establishment of an advisory committee on electric power information to tie in closely with atomic energy developments. The committee will include two leaders from private power and one from public power who will make a first hand examination of programs and technical information in the AEC's reactor development program.

In praising the tremendous growth of Longview since its birth 25 years ago, Jackson said the city and other Northwest communities are due for continuing expansion and prosperity because the Northwest is "the powerhouse of the world."

# Navy Brass Backs CVA

PORTLAND, Aug. 15 (AP)—Secretary of the Navy Francis P. Matthews spoke in favor of the proposed Columbia Valley administration at a democratic party picnic here yesterday.

"Arguments against CVA are the old tired arguments of big business who make their opposition to progress with charges of regimentation and controlled socialism," he declared.

Matthews broke from his prepared manuscript on the CVA to touch Oregon politics. He said "Oregon has been called the Vermont of the West. Yet the fact remains it would only have taken one small effort more to turn Oregon over to the democratic column."

The navy chief told newsmen during an interview that "harmony among the navy, army and air forces is excellent under Defense Secretary Louis Johnson."

Matthews stopped off for the day while en route to Puget Sound. He will return tomorrow to attend the national convention of the Knights of Columbus.

# Pear Growers Blast Price Level

YAKIMA, Aug. 15 (AP)—Up in arms over an "intolerably low" opening quotation of Bartlett pears, growers will meet here tonight with possible construction of a cooperative cannery as one of their discussion topics.

In a strongly worded statement framed by the Washington state pear producers association Saturday, the growers accused canneries of "beating down" local Bartlett prices without regard for the present demand. They also criticized

canners of "season average price agreements."

Growers charged that the \$30 a ton offered by canneries is barely half the cost of production. Several growers indicated they would let the fruit stay on the trees unless the price is increased. Last year canneries bought at \$110 a ton.






