# Soybeans Spark Grain Gain

CHICAGO, Aug. 17 (AP)—An advance in soybeans gave the entire grain market a better tone today. Beans gained a couple of cents in line with higher vegetable oil prices.

In grains, corn acted strongest from the start. Further reduction in yield prospects were reported in Iowa, although the overall yield would be above average. The economic cooperation administration earmarked \$2,180,000 to Denmark for purchase of American corn.

Although May wheat advanced on long-term investment buying, the near-by months lagged behind the rest of the market. No. 2 red wheat, deliverable on futures contracts, sold in the cash market at \$1.88 1/2. This was nearly 10 cents under the September future.

Wheat closed 1/4 lower to 1 1/2 higher, September \$1.98 1/2, corn was 1/4-1 1/2 higher, September \$1.20 1/2, oats were 1/4-1 1/2 higher, September \$0.75-1/2, rye was 2 1/2-3 1/2 higher, September \$1.43 1/2, soybeans were 1/4-2 1/2 higher, November \$2.38 1/2, and lard was 10 to 25 cents a hundred pounds higher, September \$12.37-12.40.

# Stocks Gain Up To Point

NEW YORK, Aug. 17 (AP)—Snapping out of a sluggish rut, the stock market moved forward smartly today by fractions to more than a point.

The volume was boosted to around 1,800,000 shares for the entire day when heavy trading started in Commonwealth & Southern at 5. Up 1/4 at the year's high.

Near the close one block of 100,000 shares was traded, closely followed by other blocks ranging from 50,000 to 80,000 shares.

Oils were singled out for buying attention and made the best advance of any of the major groups. Within a short time the recovery spread to rails, steels and majors, although the latter two have been held back by selling in the last two days.
