

Rent Control Hearing Here Sept. 14; Federal Funds Door Left Open

WASHINGTON, Aug. 23 (AP)—Rent control officials welcomed today the possibility of more money to enforce rent control ceilings, but still did not withdraw plans to abandon them in many areas.

A truce in the senate battle over rent control funds was reached yesterday. Senator Douglas (D-Ill.) dropped his battle for more money when he was promised that the request can be renewed in January if the situation then demands it.

Housing Expediter Tigue Woods described the result of the senate fight as a "reaffirmation of congressional support for effective rent control."

He did not say what he was going to do about his announced plans to lift ceilings in one-third of the areas which still have them.

Woods had said such action would be necessary if his agency got no more money for the current fiscal year than the \$17,500,000 figure approved by both the house and senate.

Douglas, in withdrawing his demand for more, said senators of both parties had assured him Woods would get extra funds later if he needed it.

Even if the senate should vote additional funds for rent controls later in the 12-month period which started July 1, the house would still have to go along.

New KUHS Students To Register Early

All new students who plan to attend Klamath Union high school this fall and have not completed registration should report to the counseling office at the high school building next week, August 22-26. This applies to those moving to the Klamath Union high school district since the close of school last spring.

Graduates of Altamont, Fairhaven and Fremont eighth grades were registered before the close of school and need not report at this time.

A few students of these schools as well as of Klamath Union high school anticipated moving from the district and did not register. These people should also report during the week of August 22-26.

Following the policy adopted a year ago the Klamath Union high school district and the Klamath county school system will adhere strictly to district boundary lines with the exception of a few seniors of each system who will be allowed to graduate from the school which they have been attending throughout high school and KUHS sophomores, juniors and seniors from the Keno area.

Students are eligible to attend high school only in the district in which parents or legal guardians reside. Residents of non-high school districts are free to elect the high school they prefer to attend.

Freshmen at Klamath Union high school are to report Thursday morning, September 1, at 8:30 for one-half day of orientation while the entire student body, including the freshmen, is to report at the same time Friday, September 2, for another one-half day of school. Buses are to operate on regular schedule to bring in students and return them to their homes at noon both days.

September 14 was set as the official date for the public hearing on rent control at Monday night's city council session.

The confab of landlords and tenants will be held in the city council chambers, 7:30 p. m. on that date.

Landlords and property-owners crowded the council room last night and urged that the meeting be held as soon as possible. A tentative date of September 8 had formerly been set, but real estate men asked the hearing be changed because of a realtors convention in Portland on that date.

Despite growing belief that Klamath Falls would be decontrolled by the housing expediter before any local action could be taken, it was agreed that the city should nonetheless go ahead with its plans.

A controversy bobbed up in connection with advertising for the decontrol hearing—which, under the law, must be done at least 10 days before the meeting.

Councilman A. F. Coudrey frowned on the idea of the city standing the cost of advertising and expressed the thought that "if the people are so anxious to hold a meeting to discuss decontrol, let them pay for the advertising."

However, the other councilmen voted Coudrey down, arguing that the calling of such a meeting is the legal obligation of the city under federal law and thus advertising money should come out of the city's coffers.

Council President Darrell Miller spoke in favor of the city paying the publication bill when he stated that "decontrolling would help the city's commerce in general, and not just the landlords."

Miller cited the slump in building as indication of rent ceilings being detrimental to the city's commerce.

In answer to Coudrey's intimation that the landlords wanted to decontrol to enable them to raise rents, Malcolm Teare answered caustically, "We don't want to raise rents; we merely want to get out from under rent control so we can run our own business."

The upshot of the argument was a vote to pull the advertising money out of the city's legal fund.

Only Councilman Wendell Smith was absent from Monday night's session.






