Sacred Heart To Open September 6; Building Going Up

CLASSES at Sacred Heart academy will begin at the same time as the public schools on September 6. All students who intend to enter the school in the fall should be registered by September 4.

According to Sister Lilliosa, sister superior, the grade school will be more crowded than last year, although the high school enrollment will remain much the same. Approximate enrollment expected is 186 students in grade school and 110 in the high school.

Most of the teachers returned for residence Saturday, August 13, however, the roster of high school teachers is not yet complete for fall semester. Teaching in the grade school will be Sister Agnes St. Rose, first and second grade; Sister Angela Frances, third and fourth; Sister Cecilia Frances, fifth and sixth, and Sister Rosula, seventh and eighth grades.

Teaching in the music department will be Sister Faustina and Sister Cecilia Frances. In the art department will be Sister Rosula.

IMPROVEMENTS have been made at the school during the summer months. New floors have been placed in the typing room and several typewriters have been added. New books have been added to the library and new cloak rooms have been built. Several walls have been painted in the school and the recreation room of the boarding school has been redone. The entire exterior of the brick building has been painted.

About 38 students who attend the academy live in the boarding school. Most of the residents are from Tulelake, Dorris and outlying districts. Girls are accepted for the boarding school up to 15 years of age. Boys may live there only until the fifth grade.

Fifteen transcripts were sent to colleges this spring for the graduating seniors. Thirty students were graduated.

Sacred Heart students will find added interest in their school grounds in the construction of the recreation center and parish house, a combined Sacred Heart academy and church project. This \$140,000 construction job is being pushed rapidly and by the first of the year, the youngsters will be using the gymnasium and other recreation facilities to be provided.
