Army Slates Display For State Fair

SALEM, Oregon—(Special) "Operation Unity," will present a spectacular array of military exhibits at the Oregon State Fair, September 3-11, with the five armed services combining their efforts under the sponsorship of the Salem military manpower commission. Lt. Col. Mark Hilary has been designated chairman, assisted by Col. Henry Russell, co-ordinator for military liaison, appointed by General Mark Clark, commander, 8th Army.

PORTLAND, Aug. 25 (AP)—Oregonians didn't grow as many turkeys as they planned.

The department of agriculture estimated 1,593,000 turkeys in the state now, 8 per cent more than last year, but 22 per cent of the number expected in January.

Oregon slipped from fourth to fifth place in turkey production. California is first, Texas, Minnesota, and Iowa follow.
