Prisoners' Death Causes Listed

ELLENBURG, Sept. 10 (AP)—Poisoning in one case and an acute heart attack in another was listed yesterday as the causes of the death of two city jail prisoners here 10 days ago. Coroner Henry Wager said a report from the University of Oregon crime laboratory showed Roy P. Comstock, 35, died August 29 of an acute heart attack. Wager said McCullin Bradley, found the same day, died of the effects of an unidentified toxic poison. The man died after drinking an anti-freeze solution taken from a store room, Wager said.
