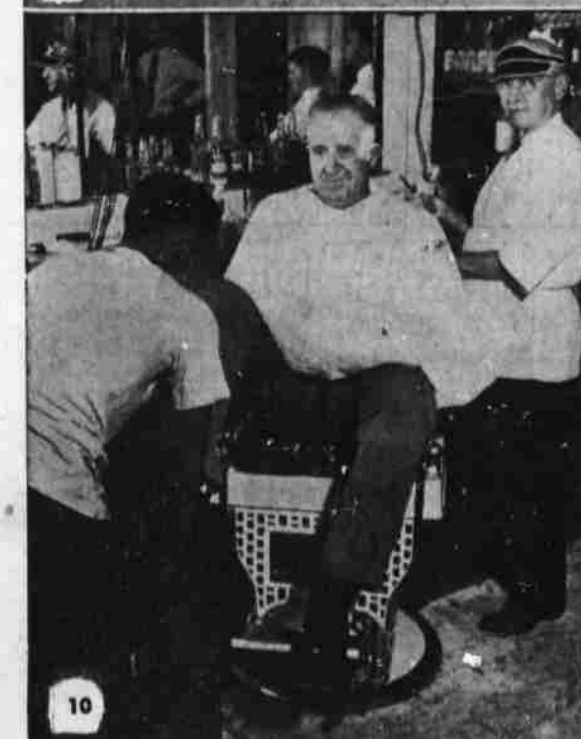
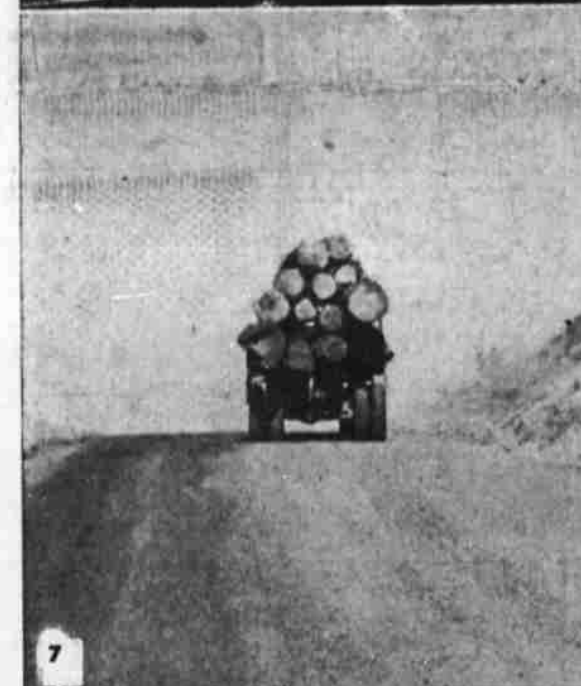
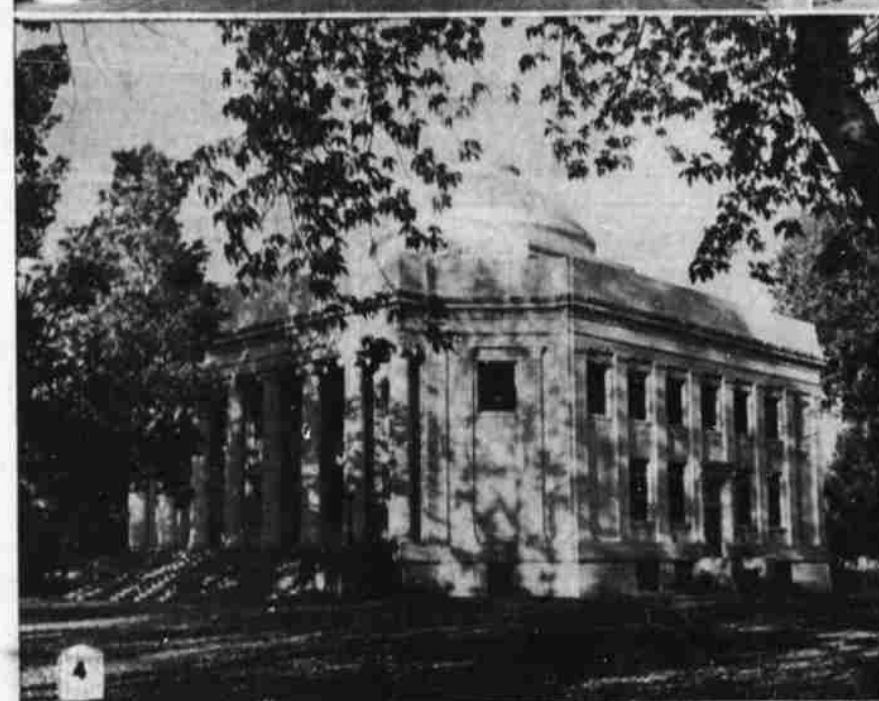
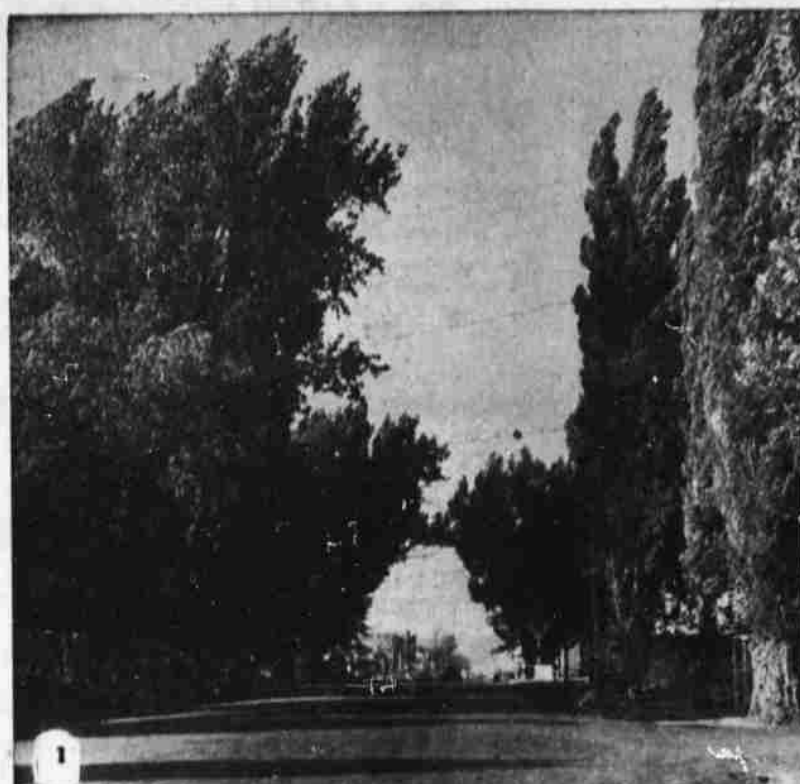


Klamath Falls Salutes the Alturas and Canby Country, It's People, Industry and Beauty!
