

### Lake Jury Imposes Heavy Fines for Gaming Devices

LAKEVIEW—Of 11 true bills of indictment returned by the Lake county grand jury on Tuesday, September 27, 10 had been handled by the circuit court by Wednesday evening. The one remaining indictment is secret.

Eight of the indictments involved punchboards and slot machines, result of the state police edict against gambling devices in this area issued out of Klamath Falls state police headquarters recently. On these charges, the following appeared before Judge Charles H. Combs, September 28.

Robert Oliver Burk, operator of the Westside cafe, pleaded guilty to possession of a punchboard, fined \$100.

Walter L. H. Geldert, operator of Hunter's Lodge, pleaded guilty to a charge of possession of a punchboard, fined \$100.

Walter L. H. Geldert, pleaded guilty on five indictments charging possession of slot machines, fined \$50 on each count.

Tommy Reed, distributor, pleaded guilty to charge of setting up gambling devices, fined \$100.

Judge Combs ordered the slot machines destroyed and the money in them turned over to the county treasurer. County Treasurer Harvey N. Sanders said this amounted to \$539.25.

**Ordered Destroyed**  
The punchboards were ordered destroyed, and Sheriff Tommy Elliott was ordered to sell the merchandise used as prizes in connection with these boards and turn the money over to the treasurer, also. The awards included, rifles, knives, flashlights, candy, etc.

The two remaining indictments were against Ted Nobles, Lakeview painting contractor. One charged rape and the other burglary in a dwelling. Nobles, with his attorney, Forrest E. Cooper of Lakeview, appeared for arraignment on Tuesday and pleaded not guilty to both charges. Bail on the rape charge was fixed at \$2500, and bail on the burglary count at \$1000. Trial date was not set.

The chamber said it was refunding all ticket money.

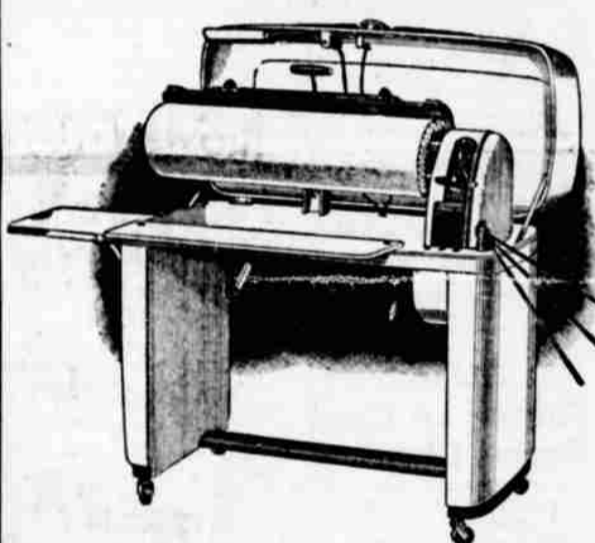

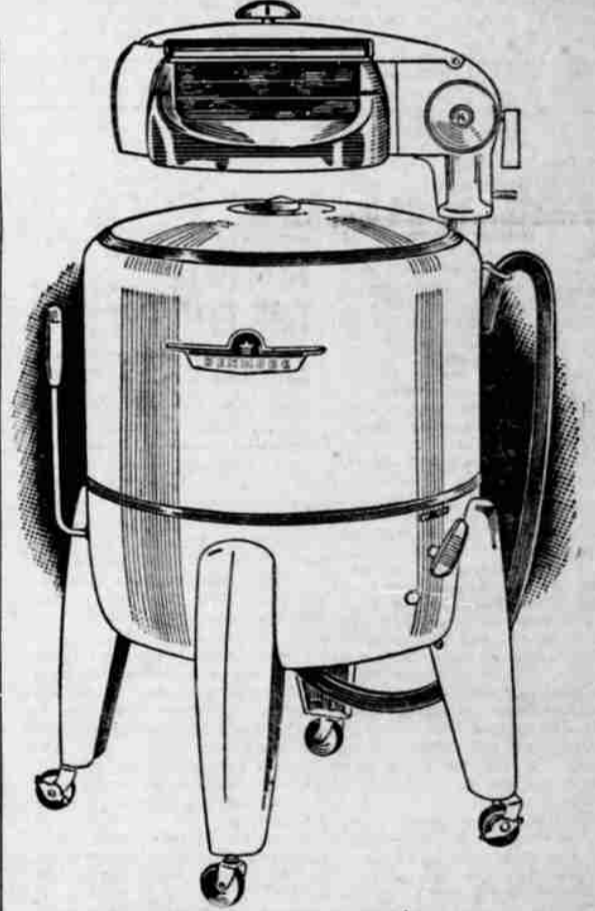
