EDITOR'S NOTE: This is the first in a series of studies from the Old Testament. The text is condensed from selections by Houston Hartie for the new book "In Our Image." Illustrations by Guy Rowe also are from the book.

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth; and darkness was upon the face of the deep.

And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters: and it was so. And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry land appear: and it was so. And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit, upon the earth: and it was so.

And God made two great lights, the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the stars also. 'Rapid Bible' Lectures At Bible Baptist
