

Elliott's Recall Vote Set Oct. 21

PORTLAND, Oct. 4 (AP)—Multnomah County Sheriff Marion Elliott will have his political fate decided October 21 in a special recall election.

A deadline provided by the recall law for a voluntary resignation expired last night. The young democratic official had said earlier that he had no intention of giving up his office without a fight against what he termed persecution by newspapers and political motives.

County Registrar of Elections James W. Gleason set the election date. He said an unofficial check of the voter rolls indicated 108,923 democrats and 99,618 republicans were eligible for the balloting. Registration of new voters since September 15, when it appeared almost certain Elliott faced a recall ballot, was led by democrats. The majority party added 720 to the rolls; the republicans 382.

The recall movement stemmed from disclosure that Elliott had misrepresented his qualifications for office when he campaigned last November. Dismissal of a veteran crime bureau officer was the spark that set it off.

Baker Man, Bus Wreck Victim

ONTARIO, Calif., Oct. 4 (AP)—The air force today listed Corp. Gordon G. Crimin, 20, Baker, Ore., as one of the March airplane personnel killed in a train and bus crash at a crossing Sunday night.

Ten of the 17 victims were servicemen. The others killed were their girl friends, wives and a chaperone. The Baker soldier was the only Northwest serviceman aboard the bus.

ROUTED BY FUMES

LAFAYETTE, Ind., Oct. 4 (AP)—Sulphuric acid fumes pouring from a wrecked railroad tank car routed 100 families from their homes near the Purdue university campus in West Lafayette early Sunday. No serious injuries were reported. The tank car, carrying 7100 gallons of acid, was derailed and its safety valve ripped off about 500 feet from the trailer camp.

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City Council Hears Police, Air Reports

Assistant Chief of Police Paul Robertson reported to the city council last night on activities in the department during September.

He informed councilmen that 371 arrests had been made, and that 141 traffic tickets and 1507 meter tickets handed out.

Bails and fines for the 30-day period amounted to \$4552.

Airport Manager Wilbur Whitcomb reported on his trip to the national aviation conference held in Spokane recently.

The city dads were interested in learning more of the joint city-county airport management set-up in force at Walla Walla, which Whitcomb mentioned. Councilman Wendell Smith asked that the mayor direct a letter to airport officials in Walla Walla, asking for complete details on the managerial set-up.

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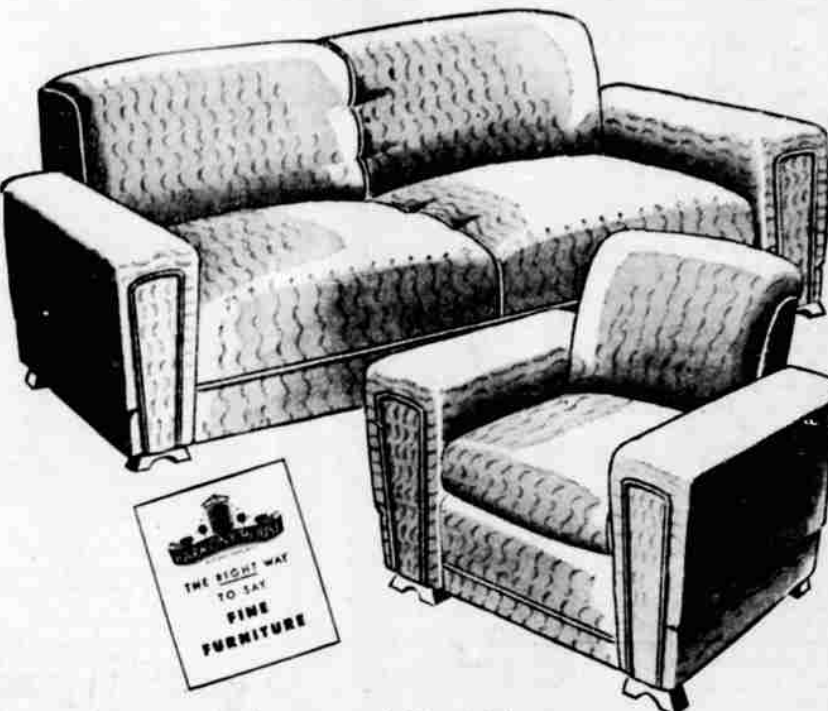
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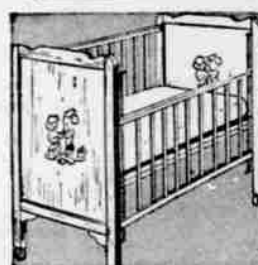
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
