CHICAGO, Oct. 5 (AP)—Grains weakened late in the session on the board of trade today. In most instances losses were not large, although they ran to more than a cent in soybeans.

The July wheat contract dropped quite sharply toward the close. This represents 1950 wheat and its price trend was greatly influenced by the running battle in Washington over farm legislation.

Stock Market Wobbly Today

NEW YORK, Oct. 5 (AP)—The stock market developed a wobbly streak after an opening burst of strength today.

The early rise carried the general price level to a new peak for the year. The market, on average, remained higher but individual advances were chopped down.

Changes either way were limited mostly to less than a point. Sales were at the rate of around 1,500,000 shares for the full session.

The market managed to make further headway despite continuation of the steel and coal strikes and apparent absence of any progress toward settlement.
