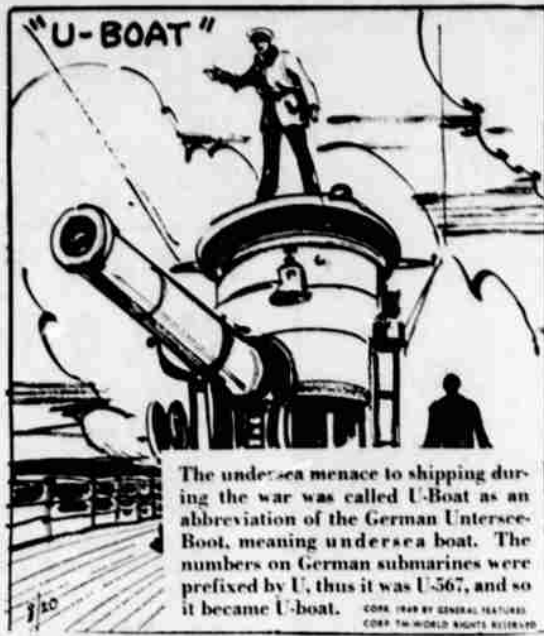
GRAINS UP STEADILY TODAY
