

Bruin-Indian Clash Could Be Crucial; Myers Picks U.C.L.A.

LOS ANGELES, Oct. 7 (AP)—Stanford and the barreling Bruins of UCLA occupy the feature spot of the Pacific Coast conference Rose Bowl race tomorrow in a contest that promises to be bruising and close.

Of equal interest is the renewed waning at Big Ten football prestige by the University of Southern California and California's Golden Bears.

Southern Cal engages Ohio State at Los Angeles, California plays Wisconsin at Madison and there is reason to hope that both coast elevens will have better luck than their conference cousins, Stanford and Washington, had against Michigan and Minnesota.

Rounding out the Saturday slate, Oregon should get by Washington State at Pullman, but Oregon State faces top prospects at Seattle against the University of Washington.

Idaho takes a rest after an unappetizing experience with the Texas Longhorns, and Montana goes against Colorado A&M at Ft. Collins.

HAPPY WARNS JACKIE TO QUIT 'POPPING OFF'

NEW YORK, Oct. 7 (AP)—Jackie Robinson, Brooklyn's explosive second baseman, has been given a sharp warning by Commissioner A. B. (Happy) Chandler to "behave himself."

On the carpet as the result of an outburst in the spring and banished for a run-in with an umpire in one of the late season games, the Negro infielder drew another rebuke for criticizing the umpiring in the first World Series game.

After the opening series game, won by the New York Yankees 1-0, Robinson beefed about the work of Plate Umpire Cal Hubbard.

In the dressing room after the Wednesday game, Jackie said, "I've never seen such bad strikes called. He actually called a pitchout a strike."

Later when he had cooled down the infielder said he was sorry about his remarks and wanted to make a public apology.

"I lost my head," he said. "We were beaten legitimately and I thought, all in all, Hubbard called a good game."

In the meantime, Commissioner Chandler had told Manager Burt Shotton of the Dodgers that he expected better behavior from Robinson.

Chandler instructed Robinson, through Shotton, to be more circumspect in dealing with umpires in the future and "act like the big league ball player he is."

The commissioner said he wanted Robinson to quit "popping off" about umpires.
