

Experts Ask Spruce Spray Plan for NW

PORTLAND, Oct. 7 (AP)—Forest experts recommend that 999,670 acres of Oregon and Washington timber be sprayed next year against spruce budworm infestation. The spraying should be extended in following years to another 1,267,610 acres, less seriously infested, said a committee of foresters from state and federal agencies and timber companies yesterday.

The committee directed the original spraying of budworm areas in Oregon last summer.

Spray Sites
Listed for spraying next season are 830,990 acres in Oregon's Blue mountains; 40,050 in Washington's Blue mountains; 39,990 acres in the Mt. Hood area of Oregon; and 88,640 acres in the Eugene-Roseburg area.

The cost is expected to total \$1,199,504 with the federal government contributing \$680,293, Oregon \$196,290, Washington \$17,856 and private timber owners \$104,865.

To be sprayed in later years are 1,137,340 acres in the Blue mountains of Oregon and 90,220 in the Blue mountains of Washington.
