The story behind the pattern "Labors of Cupid" is more than interesting . . . it is tremendous . . . there are 16 different designs, each one of which requires a pair of hand-set dies. To make one set of dies required approximately 500 hours—or three months time—on the part of the most highly skilled die cutter. The die cutter spent this time sculpturing the design in relief from a solid block of tool steel.
