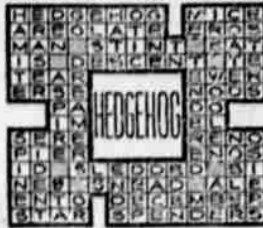
Poe-Valley-Olene

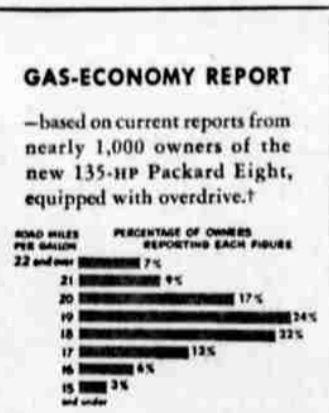

Who gets most of our customer's dollar?
