Soybean Drop Weakens Market

CHICAGO, Oct. 13 (AP)—Soybeans dropped several cents on the basis of trade today, weakening the rest of the market. Losses in other pits were limited mostly to fractions.

Heavy Trading Raises Stocks

NEW YORK, Oct. 13 (AP)—In one of the heaviest trading days of the year, the stock market moved ahead today for gains running to more than a point.

The volume of business was estimated at around 1,900,000 shares for the entire session.

The buying surge started with the opening bell. Within a short time, however, the pace slackened but continued at a high level.

Buying enthusiasm diminished after John L. Lewis proposed adding 30 to 35 cents to each ton of coal as his price for settling the coal strike.

The market is currently at the highest average level of the year. On the higher side were Shell Oil, Lion Oil, Goodrich, Hilton Hotels, American Can, Homestake Mining, Anaconda Copper, and Johns Manville.

Lower were Youngstown Sheet & Tube, Sears Roebuck, Boeing, Dow Chemical, American Woolen, U. S. Gypsum, American Airlines and Santa Fe.

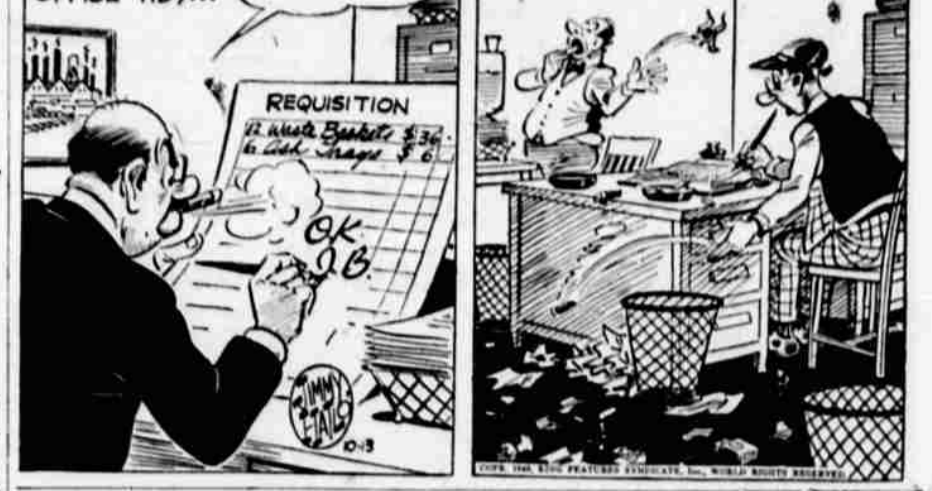
