

SP Employees Set Record For Safety

The best all-time record among Southern Pacific employees for safety to themselves and their associates was achieved during the first eight months of this year.

M. A. Nugent, the railroad's superintendent of safety, made this report this week in announcing that the company's local employees are now participating with some 58,000 other railroaders in a seven-state "October Offensive" against accidents.

Safety Meet

The Southern Pacific Shasta division safety meeting is being held tonight, 7:30 p.m., in the Klamath Falls Legion hall. The meeting is sponsored by all railroad organizations.

For the first eight months of 1949 Southern Pacific had only 5.97 reportable employee accidents for each million man-hours worked. "This shows a 16 per cent improvement in safety over the same period a year ago," Nugent said, "but we are out to score an even better mark before the end of the year."

Stickney Retires

David A. Stickney, after more than 46 years of service with Southern Pacific, retired recently. Stickney spent the last 25 years with SP as a train dispatcher, working out of Dunsmuir, Calif.

Stickney's retirement took effect at the close of his shift September 28. He started his railroad career as a telegrapher with the C&Q in Hillsdale, Iowa, in 1903.
