A'S COACHES FIRED; FANS WONDER

PHILADELPHIA, Oct. 14 (AP)—The surprise firing of Coaches Al Simmons and Earl Brucker by the Philadelphia Athletics has started baseball's hot stove league boiling...

Soon after it became known Brucker was without a job, Earl Shely, business manager of the Seattle Rainiers, said he would sound out the former catcher on whether he would be interested in managing the Pacific Coast club.

Brucker caught for Seattle in the late 20s and clubbed .339 for Portland in 1936 before moving up to the majors.

"They (Simmons and Brucker) both are wonderful fellows and I thought they did a fine job for us. But the board of directors decided we could do without them and they have the final say in running the ball club."
