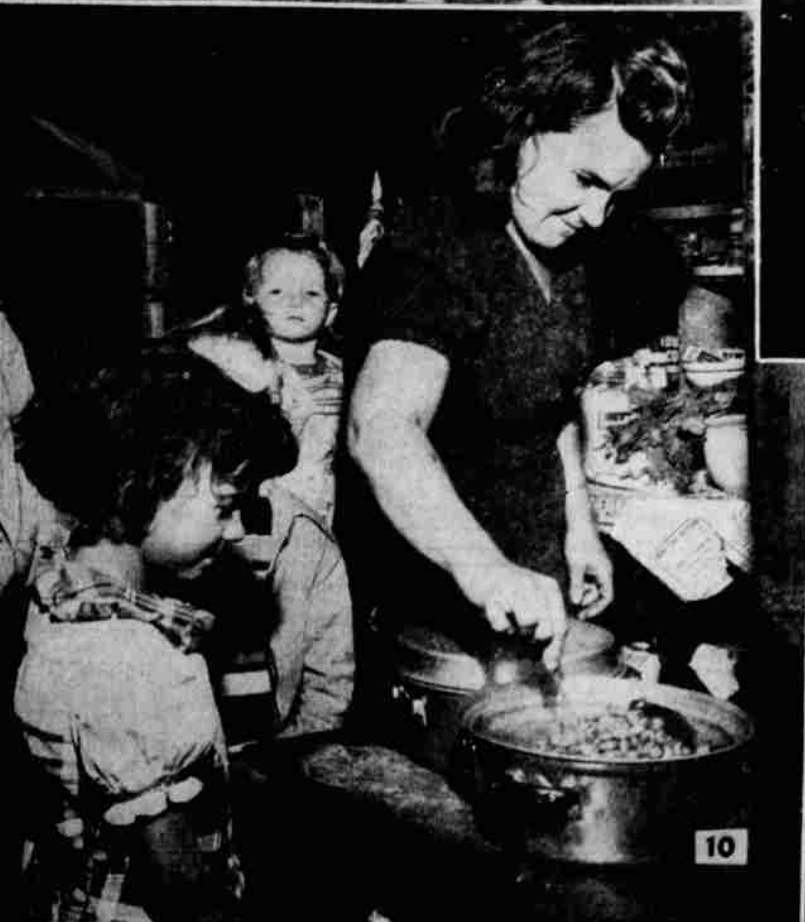


The Herald and News Week-end Photorial **Potato Harvest**
