

Speech Trial Judges Stark And Thompson

The Klamath County Junior chamber of commerce announced today that Chamber Manager Charles Stark and Mayor Robert A. Thompson have consented to make up part of the judging staff for the "Speak for Democracy" contest for Klamath county, to be held at a banquet at the Willard hotel November 8.

Klamath county high school students will be speaking for a chance to represent this county in the state contest. In addition to this honor, everyone of the contestants will receive valuable prizes from Klamath merchants — the first prize winner receiving either a \$50 gift certificate from Dick Reeder's or a \$50 gift certificate from LaPointe's.

State Contest
The Klamath county winner will be automatically entered in the state contest via radio transcription, and in the event the student wins the state contest, he or she will then be automatically entered in the National contest.

Four winners will be selected for a 4-year scholarship to any college or university in America, an expense paid trip to Washington and lunch with President Truman, gold watches and other fine presents. So far the Junior chamber committee has received entries from the following Klamath county high schools, KUHS, Senior student Benn Rous; freshman student Edna Smyth of Henley, and Freda Schlect of Bly. Other county high schools are still holding elimination contests and will submit entries later. The deadline is November 5.

Looks Like Pearson Owes Bill

SALEM, Oct. 20 (AP)—It looks like State Treasurer Walter J. Pearson is going to have to dig down in his pockets for \$160.83 to pay for a piece of printing which he had the state printer do for him.

Governor McKay refused to approve the bill today, and Secretary of State Earl T. Newby, who is in Ontario today, isn't expected to, either.

10,000 Copies
The state printer, on an order from Pearson, printed 10,000 copies of a statement called "The Finances of the State of Oregon." The half-sheet contains a picture of a state check for \$1,994,920, signed by Pearson. Below the check, it tells what Pearson's duties are.

The printer said he refused to approve the claim because "that is not a legitimate expense of the state." Newby's assistant, William

E. Healy, said he didn't think his boss would approve it. Healy said it looks like a political campaign statement.

'Understanding'
Pearson defended the document, asserting it helps people gain a better understanding of their state government.

They have been handed out at democratic party booths at the state fair and other places. The capitol guide also keeps a supply on hand.

Pearson is the only democratic member of the board of control. Governor McKay and Newby are the other two members. It takes votes of two members to approve printing bills.

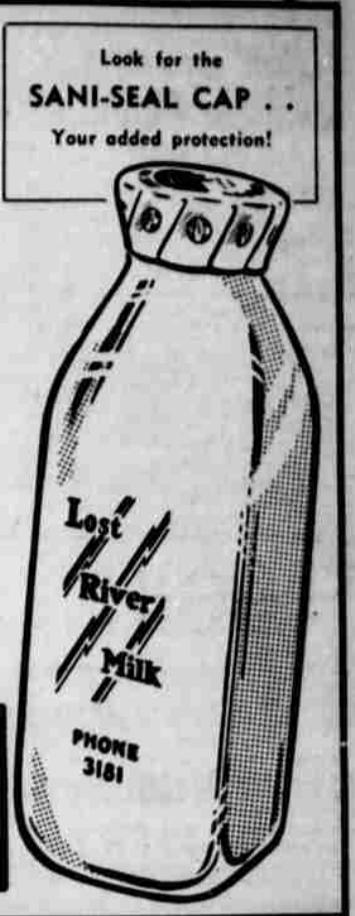

The country and route of transit are determining factors in the contents of packages, and customs regulations, which are subject to constant change, effect many parcels. In some cases, packages to servicemen overseas are subject to stringent customs rules, the post office said.

Of equal importance is obtaining information about the proper way to pack and wrap parcels for maximum safety. Unless the package is packed properly the post office may refuse to ship it.
