NEW YORK, Oct. 21 (AP)—The stock market stolidly followed a narrow price route today. Airline and meat packing issues enjoyed a flurry of favor at higher quotations but the market generally barely stirred.

International Mining advanced about 1/2 point to a new high for the year following word that directors had voted a 25-cent dividend, first since a dime was paid in 1941.
