Dramamine, New Remedy For Seasick

SEATTLE, Oct. 21 (AP)—Been delaying that ocean excursion because of seasickness? Well, forget it. Military authorities said yesterday they can cure 95 out of 100 cases with dramamine pills.

The Seattle port of embarkation said the tests were made at the request of the army surgeon general on 600 green-at-the-gills passengers on six ships on Alaska and Japan runs.

Half of the sick passengers were given the yellow dramamine pills. The others were given a sugar-and-starch pill which they thought was dramamine.

Within an hour or less, 95 per cent of those receiving dramamine said they felt better. Fifty-seven per cent of those getting the sugar-and-starch pill also said they felt bet-

ter, a reaction taken to indicate that a cure can be psychological in many cases.

Those getting no relief from the sugar-and-starch pill were later given dramamine and 96 per cent of this group then reported themselves cured.

Hindu Deaf Mute Studies in U. S.

WASHINGTON (AP)—A Hindu deaf mute is at Gallaudet college for the deaf here. He is observing teaching methods and hopes to extend deaf mute instruction in India.

India, with 3,000,000 deaf mutes, has only 45 educational institutions for them. The United States, with about 9000 such handicapped persons, has 400 such institutions.

The Hindu, Bipin Behary Choudhury, not only learned to understand and speak his own language. He also learned to speak and write English and even got a diploma from the Royal College of Arts in London.

San Francisco 'Pet City'

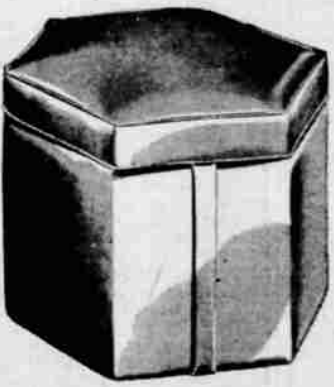

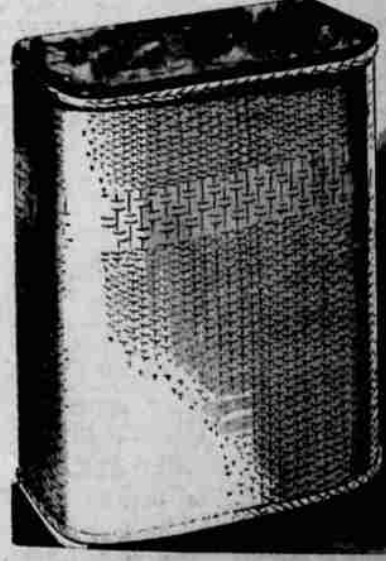
