

# Tree, Grass Funds Voted By Congress

WASHINGTON, Oct. 24 (AP) — Farm crops were not the only kind to benefit by legislation of the first session of the 81st congress. The nation's tree and grass crops did pretty well, also. In three acts, congress provided for (1) an early completion of the forest survey, (2) authorized a general reseeded and reforestation program and (3) approved an expanded cooperative program with the states for fire fighting, range rehabilitation and tree planting.

**Recap**  
There remain in the United States about 415,000,000 (M) acres of public domain. National forest lands comprise about one-third of this acreage. The remainder includes 170,000,000 (M) acres of vacant land, of which about 122,000,000 (M) acres is in grazing districts, 50,000,000 (M) acres in Indian reservations and 12,000,000 (M) acres in national parks and monuments. The remainder is in reclamation, military and other reservations.

Large areas of the public lands lie along the headwaters of the Western rivers. Reforestation or reforestation of denuded lands in these areas means flood protection for downstream lands and the safeguarding of domestic and municipal water supplies.

**Artificial Aid**  
The forest service says about 2,200,000 acres of national forest land needs artificial replanting. The interior department estimates that 85,000,000 (M) acres of its rangelands are depleted and that 22,000,000 (M) acres should be immediately reseeded. The legislation would authorize an increase of appropriations on a sliding scale up to \$10,000,000 a year for reforestation and \$3,000,000 for reseeding, by 1955. The limits are now \$1,300,000 and \$800,000.

World War II veterans with service-incurred disabilities are reminded by Veterans Administration of an important deadline in connection with their entitlement to National Service Life Insurance.

Prior to January 1, 1950, such disabilities actually incurred in service between October 8, 1940, and September 2, 1945, if less than total in degree, are disregarded in determining eligibility under the health requirements for NSLI purposes.

This means that veterans who might not otherwise qualify for life insurance for health reasons may maintain lapsed NSLI or buy new or additional insurance up to the

\$10,000 maximum if they apply before the end of the year.

A physical examination is required, however, for all insurance applicants for under this special provision. Such examinations are made by the VA without cost to the veteran.

**Question Of The Week**  
Q. Must a disabled veteran go to a vocational school or may he go to a liberal arts college, a high

school, or a similar institution under the vocational rehabilitation act?

A. He may enroll in any VA-approved educational institution or training establishment offering the course of training which he needs to insure his proper rehabilitation in line with his desires.

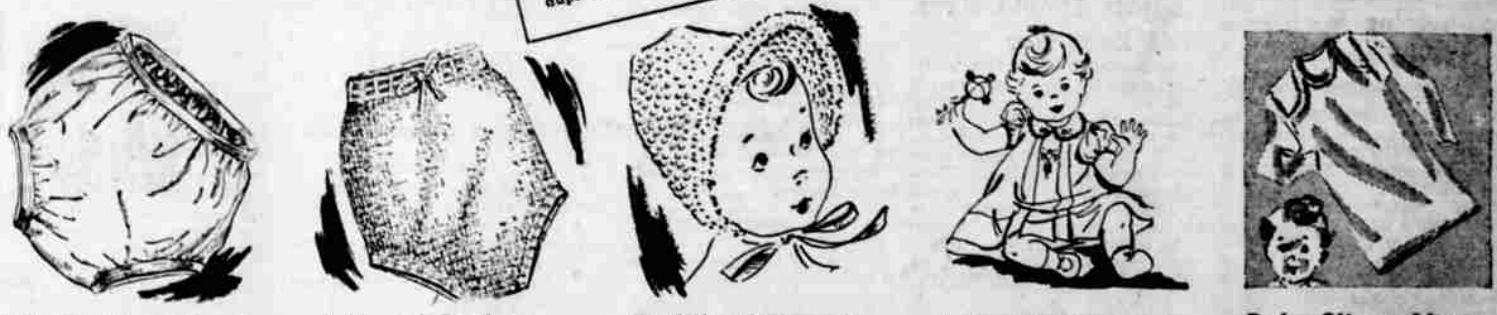
