

# Homes Razed by Raging California Forest Fire

CHATWORTH, Calif., Nov. 1 (AP)—A forest fire, racing wildly out of control, today destroyed ten costly homes in Box canyon near here and periled many more.

A strong northwest wind fanned the flames from the night. Shortly before 2 a. m., 35 families were evacuated from their homes in the north end of the canyon.

Approximately 350 families live in the entire canyon. All were ordered to stand by for evacuation at a moment's notice.

**Fighters**

Several hundred firefighters, aided by bulldozers, are on the line. Scene of the blaze is in Ventura county, just north of the Los Angeles county line and about a mile west of here.

BERLIN, Nov. 1 (AP)—Five hundred Berlin survivors of Nazi persecution have signed a protest charging that Frau Reinhard Heydrich personally ordered the destruction of Lidice after the assassination of her husband.

The widow of Hitler's "protector" of occupied Czechs was recently adjudged a "follower," the least guilty class of Nazi, by a British zone denazification court on the island of Fehmarn.
